Wednesday May 25. 1860
Strong Gale from the West at 12 from
that to 4 P.M. at 6 wind shifted to
head to the East middle a heavy
Gale from the South at midnight
more ship an account of the boats
latter a little more moderate
Lat 39° 48' Long 48° 55'

Saturday May 26
Strong Gale from the SW at wind changed
to NW more moderate barometer
rising mid and latter fine weather
but some squally
Lat 39° 24' Long 47° 09'

Sunday May 27
fine weather for a short time
middle squally latter the same
Lat 40° 04' Long 46° 25'

Monday May 28
Squally light winds from the
SW barometer falling at 7 in sail
steered E by S spoke the bark south
of New York from perlaume 65 days
mid and latter part Gale from W
squally Lat 40° 44' Long 45° 10'

Tuesday May 29
Strong Gale from W at night came to
head to the NW middle and latter part
Strong Gale at 6 steamed E by E
Lat 40° 08' Long

Wednesday May 30. 1860
Strong Gale from the West steering
E by E fine clear weather barometer
rising mid and latter part fine weather
of short duration
Lat 40° 08' Observation

Thursday May 31
cloudy rain variable wind all round
the Cape
No Observation

Friday June 1st 1860
wind E by E breeze 18 E mid and latter
Strong winds same rain head to
the NW short sail
No Observation

Saturday June 2nd
Strong winds from the ESE at 5 P.M.
more ship to the SW in fair sail
middle and latter part thick weather
at 8 lighted set the capreels at 10 rain
thunder but not much wind
No Observation

Sunday June 3rd
wind SE thick with rain head
to the ESE mid and latter part moderate
and thick fog
No Observation

Monday June 4th
wind ESE moderate and foggy at morning
more ship to the South middle part calm
latter a light breeze from the West steering
E by E Lat 41° 54' Long 39° 42'
