strong winds and rain at 4 in day
head to the NW mid and latter part
Clear quite good weather for this place
No bls

Monday June 18
wind West & NW as usual. Saw several
sail all straining & NE at night double
reefed more the NW mid and latter
part fresh winds from the Overcast
West Lat 39. 25 Long 28. 52

Tuesday June 19
Strong breezes from the West clear
two sail in sight mid and latter part
fine weather winds West as usual
Lat 39. 29 Long 29. 09

Wednesday June 20
fine weather wind West working to the
Westward slowly. Saw several sail all head
to the NE mid and latter part fine weather
Saw at 11 spoke the stern of Providence
6 months so old. H. B.

Thursday June 21 1860
strong wind from the NW running between
H. Jones & Carro double reefed middle part
winds from NW latter strong gales
from West at 8 in fore sail clear reefed
the main & sail
Lat 40. 01 Long 31. 15

Friday June 22
strong gales from the West varying
head to the NE middle moderate latter
part strong winds heading NW
Lat 40. 00 Long 32. 44

Saturday June 23
strong winds from the NW heading to the
NW by the wind double reefed mid and
latter part strong gales from the NW then moderate
saw jaggy one large ship in sight
Lat 40. 43 Long 34. 41

Sunday June 24
fresh winds from NW heading to the NW by
the wind mid at 5 spoke the king
fisher of Bedford 13 days out latter
part moderate rain & C

Monday June 25
rain light wind variable latter part
fresh wind from North heading to
the West Lat 40. 51 Long 34. 30

Tuesday June 26
fine weather spoke the Colaba of
N. Duck 60 days out mid and latter
part moderate fine weather nothing
Lat 40. 10 Long 34. 45
