Saturday June 30
moderate breeze from the S.W. head
to the N.W. same rain mid
fine weather spoke the Elizabeth
at Westport latter part fine weather
at 10 the Elizabeth set courses
for Sperm whale stand for her
saw her got a whale saw the
other whale chased them and they
all finally went to the windward
and we could not get up that is
the first time seeing whales for
more than 4 months it makes me
sick

quite a lot of 60. bbls whale

Sunday July 1st 1860
fine weather wind to the south saw the
Elizabeth sailing

Monday July 2nd
fresh winds from the south at
6 spoke the King Fisher mid
and latter part strong winds from
the south heading to the N. double reefed
Lat 41.05 Long 39.24

Tuesday July 3rd
strong winds from S.W. heading to the
by the wind at 5 saw sperm whale down
and caught one 40 bbl whale their was
a large quantity of them at 4 took him to
the ship cut him in the morning
bad weather No obs

Wednesday July 4th
strong winds same rain at 6 spoke the
marks strong gales with rain latter
part more moderate at 4 set the marks
to going Lat 41.43 Long 40.20

Thursday July 5th
strong winds clear weather saw
sail in sight in harbor mid and latter
part moderate fine weather
Lat 41.15 Long 39.30

Friday July 6th
light winds from the East
finished sailing saw a ship
sailing called her the Alpha
mid calm latter part a breeze
from the S.W.
Lat 41.16 Long 38.45
