Tuesday Th 7 1860
fresh winds from the SW had to
the 11th at 5 spoke the Draper
3 months 80 blb mid and latter
part strong breezes from the
south Lat 38.28 Long 38.10

Wednesday Th 8
fresh winds from SW at
midnight spoke the Alabama
3 months 80 blb mid and latter
part fresh wind from the south
Lat

Thursday Th 9
fresh winds cloudy mid and latter
part the same
Lat 37.25 Long 38.28

Friday Aug 10
wind NE same light squalls spoke
the Ellen 120 blb mid and latter
the same Lat 37.15 Long 38.10

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Saturday Aug 11 1860
fresh winds from the NE same squally
mid and latter part the same nothing
seen Lat 37.08 Long 37.40

Sunday Aug 12
all this day strong winds from
the NE same squally saw a bark
with a crew and man for the month had
no mast heads in the harbor
Lat 37.15 Long 37.37

Monday Aug 13
fine weather reading NW by the
wind caught lots of fish mid and
latter part fresh winds from the
NE Lat 38.06 Long 38.30

Tuesday Aug 14
fine weather wind easterly sea
nothing mid and latter part the
same from the NE the fine
weather on the 16 saw whales struck
caught one got one but badly
struck consequently lost one or
more whales saw quite a number
of whales in the time during
the time was in the lat of 38.20
Long the same say in the two 38.20

fresh winds from the south
