all sail At 10 P.M. commenced bailing
Latt in 3 = 10 Long by Chron 87 = 10

Thursday February 6
light Winds from S and fine Weather
steering W N W under all sail a boiling
Mid Part light Latter Part light At
8 A.M. finished bailing 10 saw a Shale
of Whales 5 miles off to ends in chase

Friday February the 7
light Winds from S E At 1 P.M. land
for Whales and Chart could not strike
At 5 P.M. came on board Mid Part light
Lying a pack Latter Part light steering
W N W under all sail saw nothing
Latt 2 = 25 Long by Ch 89 = 46
