 light Winds from N.E. steering
 off N.W. under all sail the Watch impleid
 in various jobs Mid Part Strong Winds
 Latter Part light Winds from E steering
 off W. under all sail so ends

Thursday February 20
 light Winds from E and overcast
 weather steering off W. under all sail
 the Watch impleid in Rattling down the
 riggin and repairing the main topgalland sale
 Mid Part light Latter Part light Winds
 from N.E. steering off W. under all
 sail so ends the Cooper impleid in coopersing
 the old barks 3 men sick of Duty

Friday February the 21
 light Winds from N.E. and fine weather the
 Watch impleid in fitting the riggin Mid Part
 light Winds Latter Part Strong Winds steering
 off W. the Cooper impleid in repairing old barks
 Latt 6-17 Long 109-47

Saturday February 22
 light Winds from E.N.E. and fine weather steering
 off W. under all sail the Watch impleid in
 fitting the riggin Mid Part light breeze Latter
 Part light Winds from N.E. steering off W.
 under all sail impleid in stowing down in
 the fore Peak stowin the ground

Sunday February the 23
 commences with light Winds from E and
 Rainy stowing of the fore peak steering
 off W. under all sail Mid Part Strong Winds
 and Squally Latter Part Strong winds steering
 off W. under all sail
 Latt 6-57 Long 144-54

Monday February the 24
 Strong trade from N.E. steering off W. under
 all sail Mid Part light Latter
 Part light Winds from N.E. steering off W.
 under all sail the Cooper impleid in fitting
 old barks so ends

Tuesday February 25
 light Winds and variable and squally steering
 to the Westward Mid Part Strong Winds
 Latter Part light Winds from N.E. and
 fine weather steering off W. under all
 sail so ends with 2 men of Duty
 Latt by Obs 8-09

Wednesday February 26
 commences with light Winds from N.E.
 under all sail steering off W. impleid in
 rattling down the riggin and repairing old
 barks At 4 P.M. bent the old main
 topgalland sale Mid Part light Winds
 and squally Latter Part Strong trade
 steering off W. under all sail
 Latt 8-37 Long 122-30

Thursday February 27
 Strong trade from N.E. and fine
 weather steering off W. impleid in fitting
 old barks Mid Part Strong Winds Latter
 Part Strong trade from N.E. steering off W.
 under all sail impleid in stowing off
 the fore Peak and stowing some ground
 tear barks and filling them with salt water
 Latt 9-00
