

# Log Book of Ship Winoyard

Friday March the 21  
light Winds from S W and fine weather  
At 5 P.M. the boat came off from the  
shore Mid Part below Latter Part light  
Winds At 9 & 10 came in for the anchors

Saturday March 22  
light Winds got one of the anchors and  
a anchor with one pathance of chains  
Mid Part light Winds Latter Part light  
Winds one Watch imploded in getting the other  
anchors and one Watch on liberty to carry  
the ships that left came in and 3 more

Sunday March 23  
light Winds one Watch on liberty  
Mid and Latter Part strong Winds one  
liberty a number of ships came in to day

Monday March 24  
light Winds one Watch on liberty Mid  
Part below 3 men run a Way Latter Part  
light Winds the Watch on liberty the  
natives got the 3 Coxwains and put them  
in the fort

Tuesday March the 25  
light Winds imploded in blacking the  
bonds one Watch on liberty Mid Part  
light Winds Latter Part light Winds a  
Painting Ship one Watch on liberty

Wednesday March 26  
light Winds imploded in Painting Ship  
one Watch on liberty Mid Part light Latter  
Part light the Watch on liberty and a  
Painting Ship

Thursday March 27  
light Winds a fair time Ship one Watch on  
liberty Mid and Latter Part light Winds  
one Watch on liberty

At Mohee

Friday March 28  
light Winds one Watch on liberty Mid Part  
light Winds Latter Part light Winds a getting  
off Potatoes and Water

Saturday March 29  
light Winds a stowing a Way Water and  
got off got Mid and Latter Part light  
imploded in getting off Potatoes

Sunday March 30  
light Winds imploded in getting ready for sea  
Shipped 3 Coxwains Discharged 1 man and  
1 more a Way took 3 out of the fort  
Mid Part light Latter Part light Winds  
At Daylight bled all hands the 3 men  
that came from the fort Denis Luty  
put them in irons the names Baker and  
Coland and Adams

Monday March 31  
light Winds and fine weather Mid Part  
the same Latter Part light Winds at 7  
At 10 got under way for sea and the  
boat went on shore with the Captain and  
the carpenter run a Way so ends  
a lying off and on

Tuesday April 1  
A lying off and on At 4 P.M. the  
boat came on board with the Captain  
Shipped in her 5 natives and 2 men  
run and Discharged 1 man Mid Part  
A running out of the Passage Latter Part  
light Winds from N.E. a Working out  
by the land imploded in stowing the  
anchors and blacking the chains the 3  
men hit in irons Conyng Luty
