Friday May the 23
Strong Winds from S S E Standing to the
E at 6 AM tack to the S W Spoke
the Bragawea Mid Part Strong Winds
from S S E Latter Part gale heading
S W at 10 AM tack in the fore
and mizen topsails
Lat 55 = 32

Saturday May 24
A gale from S S E heading S W one
ship in site saw no Whales Mid Part
Strong Winds Latter Part light Winds
saw a great number of Whales but
could not strike 4 ships in site
Lat 55 = 41

Sunday May 25
light Winds and Variables saw a plenty
of Whales could not strike 4 ships
in site got nothing Mid Part Strong
Winds and Variable Latter Part A heavy
gale from N W and rain heading N W
tack in the fore sail

Monday May 26
A gale from N W heading to the North
under close reef main topsail Mid Part
A gale from S W Latter Part light
Winds and a thick fog

Tuesday May 27
light Winds from S and thick & P.M.
blew of saw one Whale going to
geek to lose 2 ships in site Mid
Part Strong Winds and rain Latter Part
Strong Winds and thick Spoke ship
Champion of New Bedford lost for
a Whale could not strike Very
rugged
Lat 55 = 30 Long 150 = 11

Wednesday May 28
Strong Winds from S heading to the
N saw Whales to reach to lose
Mid Part light Winds and Variable steering
N Latter Part A gale from E and rain

Thursday May 29
A heavy gale from E and rain heading
S S E Mid Part A gale Latter Part
A heavy gale from S heading S S E

Friday May 30
A gale from S W and overcast weather
heading S S E Mid Part A gale
Latter Part Strong Winds steering
N E saw nothing
Lat 56 = 16 Long 147 = 43

Saturday May 31
light Winds from S W heading N W
Spoke ship Regale of Fairhaven
2 Whales saw finbacks saw one and
Whale but could not strike Mid Part
Strong Winds Latter Part Strong Winds
steering to the N W saw one Whale
but could not strike
Lat 56 = 30 Long 148 = 15

Sunday June the 1
Strong Winds from S W heading S S E
saw one ship saw finbacks Mid Part
light Winds Latter Part light Winds
and overcast weather heading N E
Spoke ship Benjamin Tucker of
New Bedford 4 Whales this season

Monday June 2
light Winds from S E one ship in site the
lost and struck the land for a rather time
with the fast Whale could not strike Mid
Part calm Latter Part Strong Winds lost for a
Whale could not strike 3 ships in site
Lat 56 = 00 Long 146 = 16
