Friday June 13  
light winds from S E and overcast  
weather impleid in boiling one ship in  
sits a boiling Mid Part Strong Winds  
Latter Part Strong Winds and overcast  
weather impleid in trying out saw  
fin backs and one ship

Saturday June 14  
A gale from S E and rainy weather  
impleid in boiling Mid Part att  
11 P.M. finished boiling Latter Part  
calm impleid in boiling out to stow  
down At 4 Lord and struck and  
the line got foul and cut and  
lost a hole line

Sunday June 15  
calm impleid in chasing Whales  
could not strike overcast weather  
Mid Part light Winds and rainy Latter  
Part calm and thick fog impleid in  
stowing down saw one ship

Monday June 16  
light Winds from S E and foggy  
impleid in stowing down Mid Part  
light Winds and foggy Latter Part  
light Winds from S W and thick  
impleid in stowing down At 11  
finished stowing down

Tuesday June 17  
Strong Winds from W S W and rainy  
saw 2 rite Whales and finbacks and  
4 ships in site Mid Part Strong Winds  
Latter Part Strong Winds from S W overcast  
the forecastle to repair and bent a weather  
saw one rite Whale did not lose 5 ships  
in site  
Latt 56 = 24

Wednesday June 18  
Strong Winds from S W and overcast weather  
saw finbacks 1 rite ship 1 boatwork of  
1 whale 2 Whales Mid Part Strong Winds  
Latter Part Strong Winds from S W  
and foggy saw a rite Whale and lost  
it came in thick did not strike

Thursday June 19  
light Winds from S W and foggy at  
4 P.M. cleared up and saw 3 Whales  
going quick to the E Lord and lost  
could not strike Mid Part light  
Winds Latter Part calm and it thick  
fog saw 2 ships

Friday June 20  
calm and thick fog At 4 P.M.  
cleared up and saw 2 rite Whales going  
quick Lord could not strike Mid  
Part light Latter Part Strong Winds  
from W S W saw a great number of  
finbacks 7 ships in site  
Latt 55 = 47 Long 148 = 04

Saturday June 21  
Strong Winds from W S W saw 2  
Whales going quick to the W Lord and lost  
could not strike Mid Part Strong Winds  
Latter Part light Winds and foggy  
saw a blasted Whale and cut in  
the throat and lips a thick fog

Sunday June 22  
light Winds and thick a boiling  
saw a Whale and Lord could not strike  
a steering S W Mid Part calm  
Latter Part light Winds from S S W  
and thick fog hading S E the blasted  
Whale made 27 bbls
