A gale from E and foggy hading S
Mid Part light Winds and rancy Latter
Part calm and foggy on board the miser
topsale to repair to ends

Tuesday July 8
light Winds from S E and over East
Weather hading S E impleid in repairing
the miser topsale at 4 P.M. bent it Mid
Part light Winds Latter Part strong
Winds from S W spoke ship Ringin of

Morgan of New London 4 Whales

Wednesday July 9

Weather under all sail hading S E saw

sail had to the S Latter Part calm
and a thick fog the B margin in site

Friday July 11
light Winds from S W and over East
steering S 2 ships in site 5 P.M. saw
a Whale Lord and Chast could not
strike at sunset took in sail hading
S Mid Part calm Latter Part calm and
thick at 5 P.M. Lord for a Whale going
quick to the S W could not strike

Saturday July the 12
A calm and thick rancy Weather saw fivebacks
Mid Part strong Winds steering S Latter
Part strong Winds from N W and thick
have a great many Whales could not
strike spoke the ship Newpark
of Stonington 6 Whales

Sunday July 13
strong Winds from N W have a
Plowty Whales Lord could not strike
2 ships in site Mid Part light Winds
Latter Part light have a number of Whales Lord
could not strike
Lat 50-57 Long 149-07

Monday July 14
calm saw a great many Whales Lord and
Chast could not strike Mid Part strong Winds
Latter Part strong Winds from S and foggy at 11 P.M.
bent up Lord for a gale of Whales thick oras
he hauled and took the line to ends
