Friday July the 25th
Strong Winds from NW heading N. N. W.
under full sail reefed top sails 5 P.M. saw a
Whale feed for him and darted and
mist him. Mid Part light Winds latter
Part strong Winds from W. S. W. and foggy

Saturday July 26th
light Winds from W. S. W. and thick
foggy. At 7 P.M. saw a Whale
going quick to the E. S. E. and could
not strike. Mid Part light Winds latter
Part light Winds from W. 2 ships in
sight. So ends last finbacks

Latt 51=40

Sunday July 27th
calm. At 10 P.M. a dead Whale and
saw the lips and a part of the head.
Mid Part calm. Latter Part calm
implied in boiling thick Weather

Monday July 28th
calm and thick Weather saw a Whale
did not lose. At 4 P.M. finished logging.
Mid Part light Winds and rainy. Latter
Part calm and fine Weather.
Latt 51=40 Long 147=35

Tuesday July 29th
light Winds from N. S. W. and fine Weather
heading W. under all sail saw nothing.
Mid Part light Winds under all sail steering
S. W. Latter Part light Winds from S. E.
heading S. W. saw nothing.
Latt 51=35 Long 149=07

Wednesday July 31st
light Winds from S. steering N. N. W.
under all sail fine Weather saw nothing.
Mid Part light Winds. Latter Part light
Winds from N. and fine Weather heading W. N. W.
saw finbacks and a dead Whale.
Latt 52=27 Long 149=47

Thursday July 31st
light Winds from N. and fine Weather heading
W. N. W. under all sail saw finbacks. Mid
Part light Winds. Latter Part light Winds
from N. heading W. N. W. 2 ships in
sight saw a dead Whale.
Latt 53=07 Long 152=00

Friday August the 1st
light Winds from N. N. E. and fine Weather
heading N. W. under all sail 2 ships in
sight standing to the N. W. Mid Part
light Winds from S. Latter Part light
Winds from S. steering N. E. under all
sail overcast Weather

Saturday August 2nd
strong breeze from S. and overcast Weather
steering N. E. under all sail saw finbacks.
Mid Part strong Winds from S. E. steering
E. N. E. Latter Part strong Winds from
E. and rainy saw finbacks.
Latt by dead R 55=00 Long by D R 147=40

Sunday August 3rd
calm and rain. At 4 P.M. a breeze
from N. E. and rain under all sail at 5
tuck in the topgallant sail and fly
gib. Mid Part strong Winds. Latter Part
strong Winds from W. steering S. saw a
dead Whale. At 9 P.M. lost sight of him.
So ends with strong Winds.
Latt 53=10

Monday August 4th
strong Winds from W. and overcast
At 4 P.M. took the dead Whale a long
side to rigging to hook on. Mid Part strong
Winds. Latter Part strong Winds from W. S. W.
and a heavy swell commenced cutting and
got a part and quit and commenced boiling
