Saturday August 16
light winds from S & E At 4 P.M.
lord and struck a whale and the
iron ore Mid Part light Winds Latter
Part light Winds from S saw Whales
and lord twice could not strike
Lat 55-13 Long 153-40

Sunday Aug 17
light winds from S and fine weather
saw a whale going quick did not lose
at sunset saw a rather Mid Part light
Winds and foggy At 10 P.M. had a shock
of a little quake it made the whole
ship tremble for a 1/2 of a minute
Latter Part strong Winds from S.W.
and a thick fog

Monday August 18
a gale from W.S.W. and thick weather
at 6 P.M. threw ship to the S.S.E. Mid Part
a gale Latter Part strong Winds lord
for a whale could not strike
Lat 55-25

Tuesday Aug 19
strong Winds from W At 1 P.M. lord
for a whale & struck one fat and
hald on 5 hours and cut lost 20
fathoms of line & canvas & iron 1
spade Mid Part calm Latter Part
light Winds and foggy At 10 A.M. lord
for Whales could not strike
Lat 55-19 Long 153-54

Wednesday Aug 20
light Winds and a thick fog Mid Part
light Winds Latter Part calm and a
thick fog heard Whales spot to ends

Thursday August 21
calm and foggy At 1 P.M. lited up
and lord and struck and bled a whale
and took to the ship at 4 saw more
Whales struck and bled a rather and
took to the ship at 7 P.M. one ship
in site Mid Part lying by the Whales
Latter Part light Winds from S.E. and a
thick fog At 5 A.M. commenced butting
Lat 55-20

Friday Aug 22
light Winds and foggy At 8 P.M.
finished butting At 4 P.M. commenced
butting 10 ours butting in 2 Whales
Mid Part light Winds Latter Part light
Winds from W impleid in butting

Saturday August 23
strong Winds from W and clear
weather saw Whales going to quick
to lose impleid in butting one ship
in site Mid Part strong Winds Latter
Part strong Winds At 10 A.M. lord
and struck a whale and held on
some time and the iron Dred and lost
the whale over ship in site

Sunday Aug 24
strong Winds from W a boiling
lord for Whales could not strike
Mid Part calm Latter Part light
Winds from W a boiling At 11
A.M. lord and struck and bled and
sunk the ends one ship in site
& whaling
Lat 55-20 Long 155-20
