Monday Jan 5
 Strong trade At 3 P.M. spoke the ship
 Sabina of Sag Harbor 1500 hundred
 Maid Part Strong Winds Latter Part Strong
 trade at 8 P.M. saw a shoal of Whales
 and got 2 of them one ship in site
 so ends impleid in getting ready to bet



Tuesday Jan 6
 light trade a heading At 5 P.M. finish
 spoke the ship Alfred Taylor of Ed. town
 with 350 of Whales Maid Part light
 Latter Part Strong Winds At 9 P.M.
 commenced hauling 2 ships in site
 Lat 4 N
