Thursday February 19
light traps under all sail steering W N W
implied in repairing the fore topgallant sail
and setting up shrouds. Mid part strong
winds and rainy. Latter part light winds
from S steering W N W and rainy

Friday Feb 20
light winds from S steering W N W under
all sail. Mid part light winds. Latter
part calm and a heavy swell from the
N W
Lat 15-15

Saturday Feb 21
light winds from W N W heading N
under all sail. Mid part calm. Latter
part calm implied in various gals
Lat 15-31

Sunday Feb 22
light winds from S heading W N W
under all sail. Mid part light winds and
swaley. Latter part strong winds from
W N W heading N W at 10 A M
Doubled reef the topsails and took in
the mainsail
Lat 16-27

Monday Feb 23
strong winds from W heading N N W under
doubled reef topsails took in the gill. Mid
part strong winds. Latter part strong winds
from W heading N N W under double
reef topsails.
Lat 17-42 Long 146-02

Tuesday February 24
strong winds from W and clear weather heading
N N W under double reef topsails implied in
stowing the new sails. Mid part strong winds
Latter part strong winds from W N W heading
N under double reef topsails
Lat 18-50

Wednesday Feb 25
strong winds from W N W heading N under
doubled reef topsails. Spent down the fore mast
Mid part strong winds. Latter part strong
winds from W N W heading S W under
doubled reef topsails.
Lat 19-23

Thursday Feb 26
strong winds from W N W at 4 P M let
out the reefs and set the topgallant sails
Mid part light winds. Latter part calm.
Lat 18-49 Long 146-21

Friday Feb 27
calm and fine weather being gill and main
topsails the cooper implied in making a
cutted but. Mid part calm. Latter part
light air from S steering W implied in
repairing the main topsail
Lat 18-57

Saturday Feb 28
light winds from S steering W under all
sail implied in repairing the main topsail
Mid part calm. Latter part calm implied
in repairing the main topsail
Lat 19-07
