Sunday March the 1<sup>st</sup>  
light winds from E a steering W under  
all sail saw a number of whales of black  
fish mid part light winds from E  
Latter part light winds from E steering  
W under all sail  
Lat 19-21 Long 148-34

Monday Mar 2  
light winds from E and fine weather steering  
W under all sail mid part light winds  
Latter part light winds from E steering  
W under all sail  
Lat 19-33 Long 150-50

Tuesday March 3  
light winds from E a steering W under all  
drawing sail better a water for Disa-bang  
orders mid part light winds Latter part  
light winds from E a steering W under  
all sail Lat 19-27 Long 153-01

Wednesday March 4  
light winds from E S and fine weather  
implied in fitting the rigging a steering W  
under all sail mid part light winds Latter  
part light winds from E At 6 A.M. saw  
the land Island of Ohee on board the  
fore topsails to appear so end a steering  
in for Ohee

Thursday Mar 5  
light winds at 2 P.M. the boat went  
in shore At 3 P.M. bent the fore topsails  
At 6 P.M. the boat came on board with  
some potatoes mid part calm Latter part  
calm At 7 P.M. bent board the cables

# As Bound in To the Islands 1840

Friday March 6  
light winds from the N a trying to get  
in mid part light winds and variables Latter  
part calm 5 ships in site so end

Saturday Mar 7  
light winds from the N a trying  
to get in At 7 P.M. came to anchor  
in 8 fathoms in 8 fathoms of water  
7 ships lying in her mid part light  
Latter part sent a raft on shore for  
water 3 ships came in her to day

Sunday Mar 8  
implied in getting off water and  
stowing it away mid part Latter  
part light winds one watch on liberty

Monday Mar 9  
light winds a Greenh Mar of Oor  
came in her mid part Latter part  
implied in watering and cleaning ship

Tuesday March 10  
got off a raft of water and stored  
a water Latter part strong trade implied  
in filling a raft of water one watch  
on liberty

Wednesday Mar 11  
strong winds one watch on liberty  
implied in filling barks for water the  
Barque of Oor of New Bedford had  
a man drowned in landing mid part  
light winds Latter part got off a raft of  
water

Thursday March 12  
implied in painting one watch on liberty  
Latter part implied in painting and getting  
off wood
