Friday May 1

Strong Winds from W and squalls of snow a steering N under hole topsails
at 10 A.M. Dabbed reef saw a plenty of birds Mid Part a gale from W Latter Part a gale

Saturday May 2

a heavy gale from W a shading N.W. under close reef main topsails Mid Part a gale from W S.W. Latter Part a gale from S.W. a steering N.W. under close reef main topsails and fore sails.

Sunday May 3

Commenced with a gale from S and thick weather a steering N at 6 P.M. hove to a heading W.S.W. under close reef main topsails Mid Part a gale Latter Part a gale from S.W. a steering N

Monday May 4

A gale saw a number of it whales a steering N wished S.W. at 1 P.M. left to the Wind one ship in site Mid Part Strong Winds Latter Part light Winds and a heavy swell on board for a Whale no success

Tuesday May 5

light Winds and a heavy swell on At 6 P.M. hove to for a Whale could not strike saw a number of Whales Mid Part light Winds Latter Part moderate but hole topsails saw finbacks at 10 A.M. took in the topsails a blowing a gale from S.E. and a raining

Wednesday May 6

a gale from S.E. and rainy at 6 P.M. Sat the fore sail Mid Part a gale Latter Part a gale from S a steering aft to the N.E. under short sails

Thursday May 7

a gale from S and clear weather a steering to the N at 6 P.M. left to heading to the W. Mid Part a gale Latter Part strong from S at 6 A.M. hove to for 2 Whales could not strike at 10 hove to give at 11 struck and killed to windward of the ship so ends

Friday May 8

Strong Winds from S.E. at 2 P.M. took the whale to the ship at 3 commenced cutting at 6 finished Mid Part light Winds Latter Part Strong Winds saw a number of small Whales hove to could not strike 2 ships in site Lat 54-34 Long 152-35

Saturday May 9

light Winds from the S.E. 3 ships in site saw a whale hove to could not strike Mid Part light Latter Part Strong Winds from E and squally hove to for Whales 2 with no success 3 ships in site
Lat 54-45

Sunday May 10

Strong Winds from E saw Whales hove to could not strike commenced cutting Mid Part Strong Winds Latter Part a moderate gale and rainy in flood in boiling
