Monday June 1
Commenced with strong winds from
E with 4 ships in site at 4 P.M.
a gale at 5 tuck in the foresale. Next
part a strong gale latter part strong
winds and foggy

Tuesday June 2
light winds from E S E and foggy
at 4 P.M. the wind shifted to the S and
blew off 2 ships in site saw no whales
a steering N E Mid part light winds
a steering N E latter part light winds
and over cast impleid in slowing down
saw finbacks Lat 55-30

Wednesday June 3
light winds from S E and thick
weather a steering down spoke ship
Electry of New London 2 Whales this
even 1/2 month out 1200 hundred
at 6 P.M. finished slowing down saw
a plenty of finbacks Mid part strong
winds latter part calm and foggy

Thursday June 4
calm and a thick fog Mid part strong
winds from W S W under all sail a
steering to the S saw 2 ships latter
part strong winds steering to the
S impleid in repairing the foresale saw
fin backs Lat 55-05 Long 146-33

Friday June 5
strong winds from W S W a heading
S under double reef topsails impleid in
repairing the foresale at 4 P.M. bent it
saw finbacks Mid part strong winds
under all sail a steering to the S
latter part strong winds from W S W
saw one rit whale going quick to the E
did not lose saw finbacks
Lat 53-52 Long 147-00

strong winds from W S W a heading to
the S spoke ship Misery of Harver
within this lesson saw one rit whale
going quick to the E did not lose saw a
great many finbacks Mid part strong winds
steering to the S latter part strong winds
from S W heading W N W saw 2 ships
steering to the N

Sunday June 7
strong winds from S S W heading W under
double reef topsails spoke ship
Triad of green Port 1 whale this
lesson Mid part strong winds latter
part strong winds from S S W a heading to
the W one ship in site saw a great many
finbacks to ends

Monday June 8
strong winds from S a steering W one ship
in site saw a whale lost for him but we success
at 6 P.M. bent a main topsails 3 ships in site
Mid part a heavy gale from S E latter
part a gale from E S E and thick weather

Tuesday June 9
a gale from E and thick weather
with a bad sea Mid part light winds
and a heavy swell latter part a gale and
over cast weather
Lat 54-36 Long 149-41

Wednesday June 10
a gale from W a heading to the N at 6
P.M. tuck in the foresale Mid part a gale
latter part strong winds impleid in repairing
the foresale saw no thin
Lat 55-16 Long 149-05
