light Winds and foggy land and struck a

Saw 2 gangs of Whales land could not
strike rancy Mid Part light Winds Latter

so ends a working on the Whale

Strong Winds and Land at 3 P.M.
took to ship at 5 commenced
cutting at 8 P.M. lash down

spoke Ship Edward of New Bedford
2 Whales at 12 meridian finish cutting
Lat 51=10

Tuesday June 30

and rancy a boiling so ends

A gale from S.E. and rancy a boiling at
