Part light Winds from S W and

Thursday July 30
calm a setting up Shooks Mid Part
light Winds from S W under all sail
a steering to the N W and thick
Weather Latter Part Strong Winds from
W N W a hading to the N W
Lat 51-51 Long 152-50

Friday July 31
Strong Winds from S W and thick
hading W a setting up Shooks
at sunset took in sail Mid Part
a gale latter Part Strong Winds
from W N W under all sail a
steering S saw nothing impleid in
setting up Shooks
Lat 51-25 Long 154-34
