Edgartown continued A D 1846

Monday August 10  
Strong Winds from SSW and overcast  
Weather under main topsail and fore sail  
Saw nothing Mid Part Strong Winds Latter  
Part light Winds from SW a steering  
NW under topsails and foresees saw  
fin backs one ship  
Lat 51=36 Long 154=00

Tuesday Aug 11  
Strong Winds from NW and over  
cast Weather a steering NW saw  
fin backs Mid Part Strong Winds  
from SW a steering NW under all  
sail Latter Part Strong Winds from  
S and overcast at 10 AM saw  
a Whale and load and struck and bled  
at 11 1/2 took to the ship to end

Wednesday Aug 12  
light Winds at 8 AM commenced cutting  
at 8 finish Mid Part light Winds  
Latter Part light Winds from  
the SW a steering NW under  
all sail did not start the Works  
Lat 54=28

Thursday Aug 13  
Strong Winds from SW a steering  
NNW at 4 PM saw 2 Whales  
load and struck one and held on  
some time and started and lost the large  
tub of line saw one ship Mid Part  
a gale Latter Part a gale from SW one  
ship in site Lat 54=48

Friday Aug 14  
a heavy gale from SW one ship in site  
Mid Part a gale Latter Part a gale  
from SW one ship in site  
S's end

Saturday Aug 15  
Strong Winds from NW commenced  
boiling spoke the Barque Anna  
of Bristol Rhodisland Mid Part  
Strong Winds heading to the NW Latter  
Part Strong Winds from WSW heading  
to the NW saw fin backs  
Lat 55=02 Long 154=59

Sunday Aug 16  
Strong Winds from WSW a heading to the  
S a boiling saw fin backs Mid Part  
light Winds Latter Part Strong Winds  
from SW a boiling  
Lat 54=20

Monday Aug 17  
a gale from S a heading W a boiling  
at 4 PM took in the fore sail Mid  
Part a heavy gale from S E and rainy  
did not boil Latter Part light Winds  
from S E a boiling saw nothing  
Lat 54=22 Long 155=27

Tuesday Aug 18  
light Winds from S E and fine Weather  
with a heavy swell impleid in boiling  
saw fin backs Mid Part Strong Winds  
under all sail finish boiling Latter  
Part Strong Winds from S under  
all sail bound to the South a steering  
down in the fore sail

Wednesday Aug 19  
Strong Winds from S a steering  
down in the fore sail Chack off  
the fore sail Mid Part a gale  
Latter Part a gale from S  
Lat 54=08
