light Winds from E S E a heading S

and Variable and rancy the other ship
in site sent a new fore topgalland sail

Thursday Sept 10
light baffling Winds and rancy the

a heading S to ship in site
Lat 32 = 35 Long 156 = 48

Friday Sep 11
Strong Winds from E S E heading S

Tuesday Sep 15
Strong trade under all sail a steering
S S E imblaid in fitting the rigging
Mid Part light Winds Latter Part Strong
Winds a steering S S E under all sail
Lat 22 = 34 Long by L 155 = 22 Chr 153 = 18

Wednesday Sep 16
light trade a steering S S W under all
sail imblaid in fitting the rigging the
other ship in site Mid Part light
light Latter Part at 5 am saw the
land Distance 30 miles bent the cables
to ends in the Parish of Abouee

Thursday Sept 17
light sea boresce at 3 P M came
to anchor in 17 fathoms of water at
Abouee Mid Part light Latter Part light
Winds sent a shore a raft of bark and got
a bunker from the home to bark ship
