a gale from W and squally a steering N.E.
under close reef topsails and fore-sails at 4 P.M.
turned out the reef and set the main topgallant
sails with a light wind from S.W. and a heavy
swell Mid Part light winds from S under all
sail a steering N.E. Latter Part light winds
from W a steering N.E. under all sail impleid
in various gobs

Friday Mar 12
light winds from N.W. a heading N.E.
under all sail at 4 P.M. a heading E.N.E. wind
N and a heavy swell from S Mid Part 9 P.M.
took ship to the W.N.W. at 6 A.M. took ship
to the E.N.E. Latter Part strong winds from
N.W. and foggy a heading N.E. under topsails
and main topgallant sails

Saturday Mar 13
strong winds from N.W. a heading N.E. foggy
weather at 3 P.M. Dubbled reefed the topsails Mid
Part at 4 A.M. the wind shifted to the S
and rainy At 6 let out the reefs and set the
topgallant sails Latter Part light winds from S
a steering N.E. under all sail

in taking up the potatoes one man sick

strong winds from E a steering N at 3 P.M.
took in the topgallant sails and Dubbled reefed
the topsails a heading N by the wind thick and
rainy Mid Part light winds from S E a heading
N.W. Latter Part light winds from E S E
a heading N.E. under all sail

Wednesday Mar 17
light winds from S E a steering N.E. & N.
under all sail impleid in various gobs Mid Part
moderate breeze Latter Part light winds from
S E a steering N.E. & N. under all sail the
watch impleid in various gobs bent the spanker
Lat 36=20

Thursday Mar 18
light winds from S E a steering N.E. & N.
under all sail sent up the fore and main
mizzenmast and yards one ship in late heading
to the south Mid Part light winds Latter
Part light winds from E S E a steering
N.E. & N. under all sail the watch impleid
in various gobs
