Strong Winds from S E and fine Weather a steering N E under all sail the Watch impleid in ships Duty at 3 P.M. took in the sails Mid Part Strong trade Latter Part Strong trade from S E a steering N E under topgallant sails and fore topmast steering Sails

Wednesday Mar 24

Strong trade a steering N E the Wind S E under topgallant sails and fore topmast steering Sails at 6 P.M. took in the flying gobs and mizen topgallant Sails Mid Part Strong Winds took in the topgallant sails Latter Part Strong trade from S E a steering N E under all sail

Thursday March 25
Strong Winds from S E a steering N N E under all sail impleid in various gobs Mid Part Strong Winds from S E and squally Latter Part Strong Winds from E S E and squally Weather a steering N E one tale in bit one man sick of Duty

Strong Winds from S E and squally Weather a steering N E but saw one brig standing to the South Mid Part Strong Winds from E and squally Weather Latter Part light Winds from E S E a heading N E under all sail impleid in various gobs one man sick
