 and foggy 16 obs in 30 fathoms water
 Green sea all well on Board
 May 27th 1833 Monday all these 24 hours light winds &
 foggy weather Lat 39° 15' 30 Long by Chronometer 71° 22' 15
 May 28th May all these 24 hours light winds & Calm
 with plenty of fog Lat 38° 34' 22 Long by Chron 71° 22' 15
