

Thursday 8th June 1833 then 24 hours begins
with a fine breeze & good weather middle
part fresh gales from east latter part
moderate winds & cloudy lat 39° 25' long 47° 34'

Friday 9th then 24 hours begins with moderate
winds & cloudy one sail in sight 5 am. Drift
to eastward middle of latter part fine winds
and pleasant lat 39° 25' long 47° 34'

Saturday 10th first part of then 24 hours fresh gales
with signals of rain middle heavy showers latter
part good weather lat 39° 27' long 40° 50' 45'

Sunday 11th all these 24 hours light winds &
calm at 4 pm one sail in sight 5 am. Drift
to eastward lat 39° 37' long 40° 00'

Monday 12th first part of then 24 hours fresh gales
middle & latter parts heavy gales with rain
at 6 am lat 39° 40' long 39° 05' West

Tuesday 13th first part of then 24 hours heavy
gales with rain middle latter parts fresh
breezes from south to S.W. with a bad
sea saw sun in black skins lat 40° 5' long 38° 25'

Wednesday 14th all these 24 hours fine breeze & pleasant
weather lat in at 39° 05' long 37° 33' 19'

Thursday 15th all these 24 hours fine winds & pleasant
weather at 6 pm saw a bark standing to west
lat 38° 39' 35' long 35° 30' 30'

Friday 16th all these 24 hours moderate gales
and pleasant weather at 8 pm took in the
light sails at 10 lay the main top sail to the
mast at day light made sail at 6 am made
the 1st part of Thayer bearing E by N 10 miles
Dist. 50 miles to 10 am and at 10 went on shore
so ends this day at Fayal

Saturday 17th first part of then 24 hours fresh gales and the
weather at 2 pm went on board & made sail & went on
of Fayal middle part foggy with sun rain latter
part fine wind & weather lat 37° 05' long 27° 25'

Sunday 18th all these 24 hours fine winds and pleasant
at 11 am one sail in sight 5 am. Drift to eastward no fish
yet lat 35° 46' 05' long 27° 20' 00'

Monday 19th all these 24 hours light winds & pleasant
at 11 am saw black fish but caught none lat 35° 05' long 27° 20'

Tuesday 20th all these 24 hours light winds and pleasant
at 7 30 am saw sperm whales got one
small calf lat 34° 54' 05' long 27° 10' 15'

Wednesday 21th all these 24 hours fine wind and
pleasant weather mizen up the blubber &
getting ready to Boil lat 34° 05' 32' 07' long 27° 11'

Thursday 22th all these 24 hours fine breeze and pleasant
weather began boiling lat 34° 15' 00' long 27° 22' 30'

Friday 23th all these 24 hours fine winds with sun rain
finished boiling lat 34° 05' 50' 00' long 27° 28' 15'

Saturday 24th all these 24 hours fine breezes and pleasant weather
lat 34° 25' 25' long 27° 28' 45' west

Sunday 25th all these 24 hours fine winds and pleasant
weather lat 34° 05' 22' 08' 14' long 27° 40' 25' 00'

Monday 26th all these 24 hours fresh gales and pleasant
weather lat 34° 19' 41' 14' long 27° 19' 00'

Tuesday 27th then 24 hours begins continues with
fresh trades & cloudy lat 34° 04' 40' long 27° 11' 00'

Wednesday 28th then 24 hours begins continues & ends
with fine winds and pleasant lat 34° 40' long 27° 02' 15'

Thursday 29th all these 24 hours fine winds and pleasant
at 11 45 am saw black fish got one lat 34° 29' 20' 26' 57'

Friday 30th all these 24 hours light winds and pleasant
weather getting ready to Boil lat 34° 10' 47' 24' long 27° 05' 30'

Saturday 31st all these 24 hours light winds &
pleasant weather finished boiling lat 34° 15' 54' 00' 00'

Sunday 1st July 1833 first part of then 24 hours light winds & pleasant
middle & latter parts variable with rain lat 34° 19' 40' long 27° 05' 30'

Monday 2nd July 1833 all these 24 hours light
winds & pleasant weather lat 34° 26' 45'

Tuesday 3rd all these 24 hours light winds & pleasant
with signals of rain lat 34° 30' 39' long 27° 06' 44'

Wednesday 4th all these 24 hours light winds and variable
with pleasant rain & clouds lat 34° 15' 33' long 26° 55'

Thursday 5th all these 24 hours light winds & pleasant
of rain & clouds lat 34° 00' 00' long 27° 00' 00'

Friday 6th all these 24 hours light winds & pleasant
with signals of rain lat 34° 04' 30' long 27° 04' 45'

Saturday 7th all these 24 hours begins with light winds with
part the same latter part fresh gales from S.W.
lat 34° 04' 30' long 27° 04' 45'
