

Thursday 17th of Octr 1883 all these 24 hours moderate breeze & cloudy weather at 8 am saw Black fish put off to sea one saw plenty of fin back but no sperm no ob long 80-100

Friday 18th all these 24 hours fresh trades & cloudy weather with fine rain finished boiling 86 lbs at 10:25 am 9:25-10:00

Saturday 19th all these 24 hours light winds & cloudy weather no fish seen at 7:30 long 62 Do 815-820

Sunday 20th all these 24 hours light winds & sun cloudy with fine rain saw plenty of Black fish & hump backs but no sperm at 6 am made the land lobes de mar bearing 64 to 25 miles Dist 6-48

Monday 21st all these 24 hours moderate winds & pleasant weather at 2 pm saw Lober de Terra bearing 315 to 320 miles at Mr Point Water Bone N. by N Dist 5-17

Tuesday 22nd these 24 hours commenced with pleasant weather at 5 am anchored in Bay Wednesday Friday Saturday Sunday Monday Tuesday Wednesday and Thursday in Bay 60 ends

Friday 23rd at 9 am got under way after 3 hours hard heaving to get the anchor & stood to sea with the wind at S by E at 8 point Bay to Bar South 3 miles Dist Middle & latter part good weather all well & clear of Bay to 4:54-5:00

Saturday 24th November 1883 all these 24 hours moderate winds with sun rain squales batt 1840 8-13 long 84-50

Sunday 25th all these 24 hours fresh trades with sun rain squales no fish seen Dist time for water batt 5-39 37-38

Monday 26th all these 24 hours fresh trades & sun squales but no fish seen Dist 6-41 89-8

Tuesday 27th all these 24 hours fresh trades with sun squales saw two hump backs but no sperm batt 7-46 long 90-53

Wednesday 28th all these 24 hours fresh trades & sun cloudy no fish seen batt 1840 8-54 long 104 through 20-78

Thursday 29th all these 24 hours moderate breeze & pleasant weather but no fish batt 1840 10-06 long 98-59

Friday 30th all these 24 hours fresh trades & pleasant weather and no fish batt 1840 10-06 long 98-59

Saturday 1st Decr all these 24 hours fresh trades & cloudy weather saw one fin back but no sperm batt 1840 10-06 long 98-59

Sunday 2nd Decr all these 24 hours fresh trades & cloudy weather with fine rain saw plenty of Black fish & hump backs but no sperm at 6 am made the land lobes de mar bearing 64 to 25 miles Dist 6-48

Monday 3rd Decr all these 24 hours fresh trades & pleasant weather saw sun hump backs but no sperm hump back batt 6-26 long 92-38 Dist

Tuesday 4th Decr these 24 hours begins continuance of ends with moderate falls sun cloudy and with fine rain but no fish batt 4-33 long 91-39-13

Wednesday 5th Decr all these 24 hours moderate trades with fine weather saw one fin back batt 2-44 long 90-25-30

Thursday 6th Decr all these 24 hours moderate trades with flying clouds at 9 am made the land Charles Island bearing 1840 Dist 18 miles batt 7-10 Dist

Friday 7th Decr all these 24 hours fresh trades and sun cloudy without round Charles Island at 12 PM Christopher point Bone N by N 3 1/4 miles Dist batt 5-33-40

Saturday 8th Decr all these 24 hours fresh trades & pleasant weather at sun set off north head at 6 am tide sail in sight at 8 spoke the Charles Brook at 9 past the Robert Barrow with two whales along side at 11 AM north head Bone 8 10 m Dist

Sunday 9th Decr all these 24 hours fresh trades & cloudy at 2 pm saw sperm whales humped to get one latter part but him in at 11 AM north head Bone 25 miles Dist 60 ends look more prosperous

Monday 10th Decr all these 24 hours light winds & pleasant boiling out the blubber at 12 PM in Banks Bay

Tuesday 11th Decr all these 24 hours moderate trades & fine weather finished boiling at 12 PM in Banks Bay in company with Charles Canal so entered for 24 hours sun sperm to Morrow 60 ends Bad luck to Day

Wednesday 12th Decr all these 24 hours light trades & fine weather at 7 am saw sperm whales put off to get one 1/2 Bone back Mull along side & began to cut 60 ends

Thursday 13th Decr all these 24 hours light trades & pleasant weather saw plenty of whales they came all help of going fast could not strike so ends boiling all these 24 hours in Banks Bay

Friday 14th Decr these 24 hours light trades & pleasant at 10 am saw sperm whales struck two of them parted the line from one & drew the iron from the other 60 ends this Day with Bad luck
