Sunday 24th all these 24 hours light trades & pleasant
weather no whales this day at 12 o'clock in Banks Bay

Monday 25th all these 24 hours light trades & pleasant
weather & sail in sight batt 0-08 North head bearing 61° 18'

Tuesday 26th all these 24 hours light trades & Calms
Cruising in Banks Bay but no fish hard times

Wednesday 27th these 24 hours begins Continues & ends
with moderate trades & pleasant at 12 o'clock redond
Rock Boar & 313 8 1/2 & 18 miles Dist batt 0-08 North

Thursday 28th all these 24 hours moderate trades
& fine weather at 10 o'clock took the Washington of
Kontuckat Capt. Haynes with 200 barrels of
muntins out batt 134 0-08 & North head bearing 61° 18'

Friday 29th these 24 hours begins Continues with
light trades & pleasant weather at 12 in Banks
Bay but Bad Luck no fish must leave the Bay

Saturday 30th all these 24 hours light trades & pleasant
at 2 o'clock left Bank Bay batt 0-10 & North head bearing 61° 18'

Sunday 31st of Dec 1833 all these 24 hours moderate
trades and good weather but no fish at day
light abiding to Bone & 324 miles Dist batt 0-18

Monday 1st then 24 hours begins with light winds
& Clear middle part cloudy with rain latter
part moderate breezes with flying clouds later

Tuesday 2nd first part of these 24 hours moderate
gales with flying clouds middle part fresh
breezes with sun fine rain latter part light
winds & Clear batt 0-06 & Albany Island bearing
East 63° round to James Island after turning

Wednesday 3rd first part of these 24 hours moderate
gales & pleasant at 5 o'clock anchor at James
Island with the small Bowdoin in 7 1/2
fathoms water Albany Island bearing East
63° a point bearing 63° in middle & latter part
cloudy with fine rain at sun rise the boats
went after turpentine when on shore found men
on shore

Thursday 4th these 24 hours begins Continues &
ends with light winds & sun fine rain at sun
set the boat returned Broke But few turpentine
at day light went again to ends

Friday 5th these 24 hours begins Continues &
with light winds & pleasant at sun set the
boats returned with but few turpentine at sun
rise started again to ends, Sun again & on getting
wood to ends with hard duck

Saturday 6th all these 24 hours fresh trades with
a heavy surf on shore could not get off wood
& But few turpentine to ends with some feet

Sunday 7th all these 24 hours moderate trades & pleasant weather
still at James Island caught plenty of fish

Monday 8th all these 24 hours fresh trades with a bad
sea on shore got one boat stove getting of wood

Tuesday 9th all these 24 hours moderate trades with
sun fine rain finished getting of wood & started
Down 1224 gallons of oil & got one boat stove

Wednesday 10th all these light trades with sun fine
rain at day light got under way & left
James Island at 12 o'clock Albemarle Point Bone
& 313 1/2 miles Dist so ends got over turpentine of wood

Thursday 11th all these 24 hours moderate trades
with fine weather at 6 o'clock rock redond Bone & 13 1/2
miles Dist batt at mro 0-06 Bone by light 93-43

Friday 12th all these 24 hours light trades & pleasant
weather at 6 o'clock saw 18 o'clock redond Bone
at Bone on dark red saw no more of him batt 0-15 by light 93-43

Saturday 13th all these 24 hours light trades & pleasant
weather but no fish batt 0-17 & Bone by light 93-43

Sunday 14th all these 24 hours moderate trades with
fine weather no fish lost the sun by not looking time long 93-43

Monday 15th all these 24 hours moderate trades with fine
weather but no fish batt 13 1/2 0-06 Bone by light 93-43

Tuesday 16th all these 24 hours moderate trades & pleasant
weather but no fish batt 13 1/2 0-06 Bone by light 93-43
