Monday 30 } all these 24 hours moderate trades with fine  
 weather at 12 M 2 sail in sight standing  
 to the northward latto 57° 5' to 132° 10' by 170° 16' 45'

Tuesday 1 } all these 24 moderate trades with fine weather  
 at 2 am broke the bark admiral Barker  
 of London 21 months out 1500 Barrels oil  
 sent the Matilda of Do latto=04° 5' to 171° 4' by 177° 3'

Wednesday 2 of July 1834 all these 24 hours moderate trades  
 with fine weather at 3 am said whales lowered found  
 them hump backs or copper bottoms at 4 took the  
 1 boats up no fish latto=14° 5' to 171° 46' by 171° 44'

Thurs 3 } all these 24 hours moderate trades  
 with fine weather at 9 am said whales  
 at 10 lowered at 11 took 1 whale  
 alongside at 12 M 3 dead whales to  
 seaward No fish latto 30° 5' to 171° 29'

Friday 4 } all these 24 hours moderate trades with  
 fine weather the whale above caught  
 to bein this day work latto 5° 10' 171° 9'

Saturday 5 } first part of these 24 hours fine  
 weather at 6 pm took 5 more whales

 moderate trades latter part fresh trades  
 one sail in sight latto=07° 5' to 171° 37' 30'

Wednesday 9 } all these 24 moderate gales with sun flying  
 clouds blowing down oil latto 5° 5' to 171° 39'

Thurs 10 } all these 24 moderate trades with pleasant  
 weather at 1 pm 13 of the crew refused  
 to do duty on account of the work it being mep but  
 it had a bad taste they say latto=21° 10' by 171° 53'

Friday 11 } all these 24 hours fresh trades with  
 flying clouds the 13 men still  
 refuse to do duty latto=3° 5' to 171° 38'

Saturday 12 } all these 24 hours begins continues  
 ends with fresh trades flying  
 clouds the 13 men that denied duty agreed  
 to turn too with the out sail & usage so  
 ends this day latto=03° 5' to 171° 37' by 171° 38'

Sunday 13 } all these 24 hours moderate trades  
 with good weather latto 03° 5' to 171° 37'

Monday 14 } all these 24 hours fresh trades with sun  
 flying clouds latto=03° 5' to 171° 37'

Tuesday 15 } all these 24 hours fresh gales with heavy rain  
 at 9 am said whales at 10 lowered at 11 took 1 whale  
 alongside at 12 M 3 dead whales to  
 seaward No fish latto 30° 5' to 171° 29'

Wednesday 16 } all these 24 hours fresh gales with sun  
 flying clouds at 4 am took along 1 whale at midnight one got  
 lost but got one

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
