

Tuesday March 17-1835 first part of this day
light wind. With sun fine rain bit in
the whale at 5 pm took the Bark Sisters
of Sydney took in sail & made all snug
for the night Sunday Island bearing S by
18 miles distance middle of latter part mod
gales with good weather Boiling out the blubber
to sail in sight but by obs 29° 3' long 178° 12' W
Wednesday 18-1835 all this day moderate gales with fine weather
at day light one sail in sight all hand
8 m blowed Boiling & standing down
oil but 28-33 sundy Island bearing
South by East Dist 35 miles

Thursday 19-1835 first part of these 24 hours mod
gales with fine weather. finished blow
ing down all the cold oil at 6 pm
Island bore S by 10 miles Dist at 8 talked ship
off shore at 12 talked ship on shore at 8 am
close in to the shore and make seen
the boats on shore found 8 men on shore
took 1 of them on board but 29° 18' long 178° 20'

Friday 20-1835 first part of this day light wind
pleasant weather at 6 pm Sunday
Island bore S by 12 miles Dist one
sail in sight mid of latter part mod
with good weather stood down 50 barrels of
oil but by obs 29° 44' long 178° 19' West

Saturday 21-1835 this day begins with moderate gales &
cloudy weather mid of latter part the
sun & obs sundy Island bearing S by
40 miles Dist

Sunday 22-1835 all these 24 hours fresh gales with cloudy
weather but 29° 14' long 177° 19' W

Monday 23-1835 first part of this day fresh gales with
cloudy weather mid of latter part the
sun & obs but by obs 28° 52' long 177° 14' West

Tuesday 24 March 1835 all these 24 hours
fresh gales with cloudy weather & sun fine
rain but by obs 29° 48' long 178° 12' West

Wednesday 25-1835 all these 24 hours fresh gales with cloudy
rainy weather have not been the
sun to day of course & obs

Thursday 26-1835 first & middle parts of these 24 hours heavy
gales with cloudy rainy weather
latter part moderate gales with good weather
but by obs 30° 07' long 178° 28'

Friday 27-1835 first part of this day moderate gales with
good weather at 3 pm made green Island
bearing S by W 16 miles Dist middle of
latter part fresh gales with good weather
but by obs 30° 36' Macaulay's rock bearing
West 6 miles Dist 30 Bnd with no fish

Saturday 28-1835 all these 24 hours moderate gales with
good weather at 6 am French rock bore S by
15 miles Dist but by obs 31° 24' 1 mile South of
French Macaulay's Rock in long 178° 55' West

Sunday 29-1835 first part of these 24 hours moderate gales
at 3 pm French rock bore West 18 miles Dist middle
part light wind with cloudy weather latter
part heavy gales from S by S split the main
top sail in close reef in it & obs but by obs 31° 20' 1 mile

Monday 30-1835 all this day heavy gales with cloudy
rainy weather & obs bent across top

Tuesday 31-1835 all this day heavy gales with cloudy
rainy weather saying too under M top
sail got down top of yard & hauled
top of masts & obs

Wednesday April 1-1835 first part of these 24 hours heavy gales
with heavy rain middle part more
moderate but part good weather got
up top fallent mast one sail in sight
but by obs 27° 35' long 177° 00'
