 Remarks onboard Monday 26th 1851
 All this day, fresh breeze from S.E. and cloudy, saw two shoals of Porpoises also a Merchant Bark bound to the Eastward so ends this day
 Lat 39-12 Long 33-55

May 27th 1851
 Remarks onboard Tuesday 27th 1851
 First part of this day, fresh breeze from S.E. latter part gentle breeze at 10 A.M. raised a shoal of Whales hauled and struck two in the head but did not hold together saw a Merchant Brig
 Lat 37-30 Long 35-50

May 28th 1851
 Remarks onboard Wednesday 28th 1851
 First part of this day, light breeze from S.E. latter part gentle breeze and cloudy, saw a Merchant Brig bound to the Eastward so ends this day
 Lat 37-25 Long 35-22

May 29th 1851
 Remarks onboard Thursday 29th 1851
 First part of this day, moderate and cloudy, latter part fresh breeze from S.E. and squally, saw a large shoal of Porpoises, saw a Bark bound East
 Lat 37-59 Long 35-59

May 30th 1851
 Remarks onboard Friday 30th 1851
 First part of this day, fresh breeze from S.E. and squally, latter part severe squall of rain and wind, so ends this day, lying under storm, trytail took in the foreward
 Lat 37-40 Long 36-40

May 31st 1851
 Remarks onboard Saturday 31st 1851
 All this day, fresh gale from S.E. saw one shoal of Blackfish also one shoal of Porpoises put out the starboard boat saw two sails one bound to the

 Remarks onboard Sunday June 1st 1851
 All this day, fresh gale from S.E. and cloudy, lying under Double reefed fore and aft sails so ends this day
 Lat 37-41 Long 36-22

June 2nd 1851
 Remarks onboard Monday 2nd 1851
 First part of this day, fresh gale from S.E. and cloudy, latter part fresh breeze from S.E. saw a Brig bound to the Eastward so ends this day, all well
 Lat 37-07 Long 36-26

June 3rd 1851
 Remarks onboard Tuesday 3rd 1851
 First part of this day, fresh breeze from S.E. and cloudy, latter part more moderate wind the reefs out first time for one week saw a shoal of Porpoises one large
 Lat 37-55 Long 35-21

June 4th 1851
 Remarks onboard Wednesday 4th 1851
 First part of this day, gentle breeze from S.E. latter part fresh breeze from S.W. and rainy, saw one shoal of Porpoises saw a Brig bound S.E. by East
 Lat in 36 Long na 36

June 5th 1851
 Remarks onboard Thursday 5th 1851
 First part of this day, fresh breeze and rainy, latter part light breeze from S.W. and fine saw two shoals of Porpoises and one shoal of Grampack also a Merchant Ship bound S.E.
 Lat 38-26 Long 35-59

June 6th 1851
 Remarks onboard Friday 6th 1851
 First part of this day, gentle breeze from S.W. latter part fresh gale and squally, saw three shoals supposed to be Grampack
 Lat 39-30 Long 34-37
