June 7th 1851
Remarks onboard Saturday 7th 1851
All the day fresh gale from S.W. and squally latter part shing. Saw a shoal of Blackfish also a Miniback
Lat 39-40 Long 70-00

June 8th 1851
Remarks onboard Sunday 8th 1851
All the day, fresh gale from S.W. and squally, spoke the Schooner, 28 Days out, Chase and gained with her saw three shoals of Porpoise and one shoal of Cowfish also saw a ship bound C.P.C. at sunset the Cloud bore N.W. Dist 1 mile

June 9th 1851
Remarks onboard Monday 9th 1851
All this day, fresh breeze from S.W. and cloudy, spoke the Robert Craik 20 Days out, Chase and gained with her, and the Schooner saw two shoals of Porpoise at sunset the Cloud bore N.W. Dist 5 miles

June 10th 1851
Remarks onboard Tuesday 10th 1851
First part of this day, fresh breeze from S.W. latter part gale, and squally, lying off and on, Cloud under short sail, accompanying with the Robert Craik and Schooner saw several shoals of Porpoise at sunset the Cloud bore N.W. Dist 2 miles

June 11th 1851
Remarks onboard Wednesday 11th 1851
First part of this day, fresh gale and rainy, latter part gentle breeze from North, first time for 5 weeks, saw the Robert Craik and Schooner, also three other boats at sunset the Cloud bore North 10 miles Dist

June 12th 1851
Remarks onboard Thursday 12th 1851
First part of this day, gentle breeze from North, latter part gentle breeze from N.W. saw several shoals of Porpoise and one Miniback saw the Schooner Robert Craik and the Schooner also two Merchantmen bound C.P.C. at sunset the Cloud bore N.W. Dist 15 miles

June 13th 1851
Remarks onboard Friday 13th 1851
All this day, light air from West and fine saw the Schooner and Robert Craik, located at 10 miles and took onboard 888 Barrels and 5000 Union seeds this day

June 14th 1851
Remarks onboard Saturday 14th 1851
All this day, gentle breeze from West and fine saw the Schooner Robert Craik and a large former Boat Bark took onboard 30 Barrels of Potatoes and a bagel

June 15th 1851
Remarks onboard Sunday 15th 1851
All this day, light air from S.W. and fine saw one shoal of Porpoise and several shoals of Blackfish spoke the Barker, Cook 14 Months out 300 Sperm at sunset the Cloud bore North Dist 10 miles

June 16th 1851
Remarks onboard Monday 16th 1851
First part of this day, calm latter part gentle breeze from S.E. and fine saw two shoals of Porpoise and two Minibacks spoke the Barker, Cook 14 Months out 300 Sperm from Boston, Chase saw the Robert Craik and a Whaling Ship bound East at sunset the Cloud bore East Dist 10 miles

June 17th 1851
Remarks onboard Tuesday 17th 1851
All this day, gentle breeze from S.E. and at 3-4 o'clock saw high light of Merchantmen and one Whaler also saw Miniback one shoal of Porpoise
