First part of this day light are from S.W. latter part gentle breeze from North saw two shoals of Blackfish toward the Boat but did not get hold saw one shoal of Grampius also one shoal of Porpoise saw a Bark standing to the Eastward supposed to be a Whaler so ends this day

Remarks onboard Wednesday 6th 1851
First part of this day gentle breeze from S.W. latter part fresh gale from N.W. and finally with a heavy sea saw several shoals of Grampius saw a Whaling Bark bound to

Aug 7th

1851

Remarks onboard Thursday 7th 1851
All this day fresh gales from N.W. and S.W. saw a Merchant ship bound to C.S. Coast also saw two shoals of Grampius a breaching so ends this day lying too under double reef. Ends

Aug 8th

1851

Remarks onboard Friday 8th 1851
First part of this day fresh gale from N.W. and S.W. with middle wind from S.W. latter part more moderate and cloudy saw a Whaling Ship bound to C.S. Coast

Aug 9th

1851

Remarks onboard Saturday 9th 1851
All this day fresh breeze from N.W. West and S.W. saw a sail standing to the West also saw a Whaling Bark standing to the West saw one shoal of Porpoise and one shoal of Grampius

Aug 10th

1851

Remarks onboard Sunday Aug 10th 1851
All this day gentle breeze from N.W. West and S.W. saw a Merchant Ship bound to the Westward also saw a shoal of Porpoise

Lat 40-19 Long 34-39

Aug 11th

1851

Remarks onboard Monday Aug 11th 1851
First part of this day gentle breeze and fine latter part fresh breeze from S.W. and spring saw three Merchant Ships bound to the West saw many six or eight whales supposed to be Grampius

Lat 39-36 Long 35-28

Aug 12th

1851

Remarks onboard Tuesday 12th 1851
First part of this day fresh gale from S.W. West and S.W. latter part gentle breeze from West with a heavy sea saw many shoals of Porpoise

Lat 40-56 Long 35-48

Aug 13th

1851

Remarks onboard Wednesday Aug 13th 1851
First part of this day light are and suppling latter part fresh breeze from W.S.W. and S.W. saw three Ships bound to Coast and a Bark bound to the Westward also saw three shoals of Porpoise and one shoal of Grampius

1851

Remarks onboard Thursday 14th 1851
First part of this day fresh gale from W.S.W. and S.W. with heavy rain latter part more moderate and fine saw a Merchant Bark bound to the Westward
