1851

Remarks onboard Friday Aug 15 1851  
All this day gentle breeze from N West  
and cloudy at 10 A M spoke the Brig  
Edgar of Lima 6 1/2 Months out 200 Blk  
Sperm oil and heard from a number of others  
Litt 40-31 Long 32-15

Aug 16

1851

Remarks onboard Saturday Aug 16 1851  
First part of this day gentle breeze and fine weather  
latter part Calm saw two Shoals of Grampus  
one Shoal of Porpoise also three seals  
at Sunset Flood bore South East 20 Miles

Aug 17

1851

Remarks onboard Sunday Aug 17 1851  
All this day gentle breeze from NW and shade  
saw three Whaling Ships, two Barks and the  
Schooner Union & the Schooner Mary at 10  
3/4 Months out (Clear) saw two Shoals of Grampus  
& two Shoals of Porpoise at Sunset Flood West 10

Aug 18

1851

Remarks onboard Monday Aug 18 1851  
First part of this day gentle breeze from S W  
latter part calm breeze with a heavy sea saw  
small Shoals of Grampus saw three Barks two  
Merchantmen bound East and one Whale Ship  
at 1 P M raised four Sperm Whales raised the  
Boats Spruck and killed one Supper 75 Churn  
Flood bearing S E East Dist 25 Miles so and so

Aug 19

1851

Remarks onboard Tuesday Aug 19 1851  
First part of this day fair breeze from  
S W and cloudy, latter part light are from North  
and fine at 11 A M commenced (cutting) took in  
the Junk and Cape left the Boddie overboard  
saw one Shoal of Grampus and Bark bound  
at Sunset Flood bore N E Dist 8 Miles

Aug 20

1851

Remarks onboard Wednesday Aug 20 1851  
All this day Calm saw two Whaling  
Bark and Bark bound in the Boddie of  
the Whale and started the work again  
at Sunset Flood bore North Dist 40 Miles

Aug 21

1851

Remarks onboard Thursday Aug 21 1851  
First part of this day light are from  
S W latter part gentle breeze from S West  
Spoke the Bark Mary Gardner of Sag  
Harbour Smiths Mouth 50 Days out (Clear)  
at Sunset Flood bore S Dist 20 Miles

Aug 22

1851

Remarks onboard Friday Aug 22 1851  
First part of this day light are from S West  
latter part calm with light breeze (faded) cooking  
and toward down there being 24 Blk Head  
& 60 Boddie spoke the Ship Santa 15 Days out  
Clear at Sunset Flood bore S Dist 18 Miles

Aug 23

1851

Remarks onboard Saturday Aug 23 1851  
First part of this day calm latter part gentle  
breeze from S West saw six Merchantmen bound  
to the Eastward exchanged Colours with a (English)  
Brig bound (Capt saw a Whaling Bark bound to  
saw several Shoals of Grampus and a Calf of the  
Litt 58-51 Long 52-00

Aug 24

1851

Remarks onboard Sunday Aug 24 1851  
All this day Calm and fine saw two Shoals  
of Grampus one Shoal of Grampus saw one  
Merchantmen bound to the Eastward saw a  
Whaling Bark went onboard the Fern  
of Survey Ryder Master 5 Months out  
the Hundred and fifty Blk of Sperm oil  
Litt 58-51 Long 52-29

Aug 25

1851

Remarks onboard Monday Aug 25 1851  
First part of this day calm latter part gentle  
breeze from South and fine saw the Brig Fern  
also another Whaling Bark and 15 Merchantmen  
from Shoals of Grampus two Shoals of Grampus  
at Sunset Flood bore S Dist 50 Miles
