Sept 3

1851

Remarks onboard Friday Sept 3 1851
First part of this day gentle breeze from S. W. and squally latter part gentle breeze from East and fine saw two Whaling ships one Bark & Brig, also a Merchant Brig. Sighted Cast few porpoises & several fish pods (Tramper) at Sunset. Flood bore North Dist 15 Miles

Sept 4

1851

Remarks onboard Saturday Sept 4 1851
All this day light are and pleasant saw shoal of Grandpaul and Porpoise saw some sails of Whaler's ships Bark & Brig. Perry Brig. Loph's Schooner and also a light schooner saw one of the Brig in Chalk of Whaler to end this day at Sunset Flood bore N. E. Dist 20 Miles

Sept 5

1851

Remarks onboard Sunday Sept 5 1851
All this day light are from South and pleasant saw Grandpaul Blackbird & Porpoise (saw) with 250 sperm with Virginia 160 Old Sperm and saw the Cooper all saw several other Whalers on ship Boiling at Sunset Flood bore North Dist 25 Miles

Sept 6

1851

Remarks onboard Monday Sept 6 1851
First part of this day Calm latter part light are from S. East and pleasant saw several shoal of Grandpaul & Porpoise saw several Whalers spoke to Governor Hopkins of Dartmouth 2 Munt out Chan at Sunset Flood bore S. E. Dist 20 Miles

Sept 7

1851

Remarks onboard Tuesday Sept 7 1851
First part of this day calm latter part gentle breeze from N. E. by E. and fine saw a number shoal of Grandpaul & Porpoise saw three Whaler's standing into a Flood at Sunset Flood bore S. E. Dist 45 Miles

1851

Remarks onboard Wednesday Sept 10 1851
First part of this day light are from S. East latter part light are from S. East saw a number of Whaler's also a number shoal of Grandpaul & Porpoise (saw) with the school of Lino 7 Munt out with 220 sperm Smith & Hatter at Sunset Flood bore East Dist 15 Miles

Sept 11

1851

Remarks onboard Thursday Sept 11 1851
First part of this day light are from S. E. and fine latter part gentle breeze from South saw three Whalers the shoal of Grandpaul & one of Porpoise saw a Merchant ship bound at Sunset Flood bore N. by W. Dist 40 Miles

Sept 12

1851

Remarks onboard Friday Sept 12 1851
First part of this day gentle breeze from South latter part fresh breeze from S. by W. and squally saw two Whaling Barks bound with four Merchant ships bound (East) with 87-21 Aug 27-11

Sept 13

1851

Remarks onboard Saturday Sept 13 1851
First part of this day fresh gale from South & squally with much Thunder Lightning & rain Middle more moderate latter part breeze again squally saw a Whaling Bark also two other sails at Sunset Fog bore South Dist 40 Miles

Sept 14

1851

Remarks onboard Sunday Sept 14 1851
First part of this day fresh breeze from S. E. with squally with Thunder Lightning & Rain latter gentle breeze from N. West and pleasant saw a Whaling Bark & ship running down (saw) saw one shoal of Porpoise by end this day going off & on (saw) under full power reefed (saw) & (saw) bound in to Governor's by morning of pleasant and not calm at Sunset Fog bore S. E. Dist 10 Miles
