First part of this day, fresh breeze from East and squally latter part fresh breeze and squally saw a Whaling (Horn) Brig to end this day (fine) under full sail (under full sail) and Light Lat 35-13 Long 25-08

Remarks onboard Sunday, Sept 28 1851
First part of this day, gentle breeze from East and squally latter part Calm and clear saw one ship supposed to be a Whaler Lat 35-46 Long 24-33

Sept 29

1851

Remarks onboard Monday, Sept 29 1851
First part of this day, Calm and clear latter part gentle breeze from N. West and squally saw two (Horn) Whalers and one small (Horn) Whaler Lat 35-09 Long 24-48

Sept 30

1851

Remarks onboard Tuesday, Sept 30 1851
First part of this day, gentle breeze from N. West latter part squally breeze and squally saw a (Horn) Whaler ship running S. East also saw one (Horn) Whaler and one (Horn) Whaler Lat 34-48 Long 24-47

Remarks onboard Wednesday, Oct 1 1851
First part of this day, gentle breeze from North latter part fresh breeze and squally saw a (Horn) Whaler and one (Horn) Whaler Lat 34-20 Long 24-52

Oct 2

1851

Remarks onboard Thursday, Oct 2 1851
All this day fresh breeze from N. E. East Lat 34-47 Long 24-47

Oct 3

1851

Remarks onboard Friday, Oct 3 1851
First part of this day, fresh breeze from East and squally latter part gentle breeze and fine Lat 35-33 Long 25-12

Remarks onboard Saturday, Oct 4 1851
All this day, wind from N. E. to S. East & moderate with hazy, cloudy saw one (Horn) Whaler of (Horn) Whaler and one small (Horn) Whaler Lat 35-12 Long 24-57

Oct 5

1851

Remarks onboard Sunday, Oct 5 1851
All this day, gentle breeze from East and fine weather saw a (Horn) Whaler bound N. W. West to end this day, all well Lat 34-48 Long 24-48

Oct 6

1851

Remarks onboard Monday, Oct 6 1851
First part of this day, gentle breeze from East latter part fresh breeze from E. N. E. saw one (Horn) Whaler also a (Horn) Whaler supposed to be a (Horn) Whaler at twenty (Horn) Whalers before sunset sailed two (Horn) Whalers bound N. W. West toward the Coast but did not see them from the Coast Lat 34-42 Long 24-01

Oct 7

1851

Remarks onboard Tuesday, Oct 7 1851
All this day, fresh breeze from E. East and cloudy saw one (Horn) Whaler of (Horn) Whaler and one (Horn) Whaler supposed to be a (Horn) Whaler also saw a (Horn) Whaler flying under Double reef mainsail and full taking on of oil supposed to be the (Horn) Whaler of (Horn) Whaler Lat 34-55 Long 24-19

1851

Remarks onboard Wednesday, Oct 8 1851
First part of this day, fresh breeze from East latter part gentle breeze and fine saw a (Horn) Whaler saw one (Horn) Whaler supposed to be a (Horn) Whaler Lat 34-57 Long 24-16

Oct 9

1851

Remarks onboard Thursday, Oct 9 1851
All this day, gentle breeze and fine saw a (Horn) Whaler bound to the Eastward saw one (Horn) Whaler of (Horn) Whaler to end this day Lat 34-50 Long 24-20
