 W S West and clear latter part fresh
 gales from West with heavy squalls

 All this day, fresh gales from S West
 with heavy squalls of wind and rain
 accompanied with Thunder & Lightning
 Lat 22=58 Long 100

 Remarks onboard Sunday Oct [#] 26 1851
 First part of this day, fresh gales
 from S West and squally latter part
 fresh breeze and squally then three last
 days lying under three reefed Cross sail
 and Stays Presail so ends this day
 Lat 21=52 Long 22=58

 Remarks onboard Monday Oct [#] 27 1851
 First part of this day, strong gale from
 S West and squally, latter part gentle
 breeze from West and squally standing
 to the South with all sail set so ends this day
 Lat 21=15 Long 23=13

 First part of this day, gentle breeze from
 West latter part gentle breeze from S West
 with a heavy squall of rain & wind from the South
 Lat 21=43 Long 24=21

 Remarks onboard Wednesday Oct [#] 29 1851
 First part of this day, gentle breeze from
 S W by West and squally latter part fresh
 breeze from W S W and fine saw two Shearh
 of Caspian so ends this day, all with
 Lat 21=29 Long 26=24

 Remarks onboard Thursday Oct [#] 30 1851
 First part of this day, gentle breeze from
 S West and squally latter part gentle breeze from
 West and pleasant saw one of Caspian so ends this day
 Lat 22=09 Long 28=01

 Remarks onboard Friday Oct [#] 31 1851
 First part of this day, light air from W S W and
 pleasant Middle Cabin latter part gentle breeze from
 South saw a Merchant Bark bound N East
 set up the Rigging fore and aft so ends this day
 Lat 22=00 Long 28=14

 Remarks onboard Saturday Nov [#] 1 1851
 First part of this day, gentle breeze from S S E
 latter part fresh breeze from South to S West
 and squally with rain broke the hook to the
 back of the Mast and fixed it
 Lat 21=30 Long 31=10

Nov [#] 2
 1851
 Remarks onboard Sunday Nov [#] 2 1851
 First part of this day, gentle breeze from S W
 and cloudy Middle Cabin latter part light air from
 North West and very pleasant so ends this day
 Lat 21=35 Long 32=05
