Remarks onboard Sunday, Nov 16 1851
First part of this day gentle breeze from N.W. to S.W. Galt and S.W. gale with clouds latter part light air from N.W. West to South with clouds and very flaky ends this day

Nov 17

Remarks onboard Monday, Nov 17 1851
First part of this day light air from N.W. and S.W. gale latter part gentle breeze from South and fine ends this day
Lat 28-20 Long 89-00

Nov 18

Remarks onboard Tuesday, Nov 18 1851
First part of this day light air from North latter part gentle breeze from N.W. Galt and fine saw one Pinback one Horn Bireg one Sch one full sized Brig running South
Lat 27-58 Long 89-39

Nov 19

Remarks onboard Wednesday, Nov 19 1851
All this day gentle breeze from West and S.W. gale finished (Landing) saw two Merchants and beyond S.W. Galt
Lat 27-17 Long 89-48

Nov 20

Remarks onboard Thursday, Nov 20 1851
First part of this day light air from West and S.W. gale with rain latter part fresh breeze from N.W. Galt and S.W. gale saw three Merchants bound to the South secured the West and took in the Mail Boat so ends this day ending

Remarks onboard Friday, Nov 21 1851
First part of this day fresh breeze from N.W. Galt to S.W. latter part fresh breeze from S.W. Galt and S.W. gale ends this day

Nov 22

Remarks onboard Saturday, Nov 22 1851
First part of this day heavy gale from S.W. Galt and S.W. gale under three reefs fore sail at 12 o'clock wind shifted to S.W. latter part heavy gale from S.W. Galt and S.W. gale under storm fore sail and small piece of the main sail shipped and the Mast Boat and Galley so ends this day

Remarks onboard Sunday, Nov 23 1851
First part of this day fresh breeze from West and very S.W. gale latter part fresh breeze from S.W. Galt and S.W. gale the Horn Bireg full sized Brig from Boston

Remarks onboard Monday, Nov 24 1851
First part of this day fresh gale from S.W. Galt and S.W. gale running under reef fore sail latter part gentle breeze from S.W. Galt and S.W. gale saw a Ship standing to the South West went to the fore sail and went to and bent it
