First part of this day fresh breeze from North latter part light breeze from N
Saw 2 sails of Merchantmen bound Eastward saw
one shoal of Porpoise hauled with the Brig.
Saw of Course 8 miles out Clear at
Sunset (Shore bore N E Dist 25 Miles)

June 23

1852

Remarks onboard Wednesday June 23 1852
First part of this day light breeze from N W
latter part gentle breeze from N W
Saw the Sun also another Whaling Bark
Saw two Merchantmen bound Eastward
Went the sun Porchil and sent the oil on
Latt 58-46 Long

June 24

1852

Remarks onboard Thursday June 24 1852
First part of this day gentle breeze from
N W and rainy latter part gentle breeze from
N W and fine saw one Merchantmen
bound East also one Whaling Bark saw
three shoals of Porpoise and the
at sunset (Shore bore S E Dist 10 Miles)

June 25

1852

Remarks onboard Friday June 25 1852
First part of this day gentle breeze from
N W latter part gentle breeze from West
Saw two Merchantmen bound East also
saw one shoal of Porpoise and Cowfish
at sunset (Shore bore South Dist 20 Miles)

June 26

1852

Remarks onboard Saturday June 26 1852
First part of this day gentle breeze from
N W latter part gentle breeze from N W
Saw (Bark) with out lumber to end the
Latt 39-48 Long 28-01

June 27

1852

Remarks onboard Sunday June 27 1852
First part of this day gentle breeze from N W
latter part from N W saw two shoals of Porpoise
at sundown (Shore bore South Dist 25 Miles)

1852

Remarks onboard Monday June 28 1852
First part of this day gentle breeze from West
latter part gentle breeze from North saw two
Bark and a Merchant Schooner bound East
Latt 39-38 Long 29-58

June 29

1852

Remarks onboard Tuesday June 29 1852
First part of this day gentle breeze from North
and pleasant latter part Calm and clear saw
two shoals of Porpoise spoke the Bark Spartan
also the Bark Montgomery of New Bedford
18 Day out Chan Cushing. Hauled saw two
other Whaling Barks and four other sails
at sunset (Shore bore N E Dist 10 Miles)
Saw all three Boats and had a Bull

June 30

1852

Remarks onboard Wednesday June 30 1852
First part of this day Calm and clear latter
part light breeze from N W by S and pleasant
Saw two shoals of Porpoise and 8 sails of
Whalmen & Barks one large one (Horn Brig)
at sunset (Shore bore S E Dist 15 Miles)

July 1

1852

Remarks onboard Thursday July 1 1852
All the day gentle breeze from N W by W
and pleasant saw one Merchant Ship bound
East saw two shoals of Porpoise and one
of Blackfish hauled but got nothing
at sunset (Shore bore N W Dist 25 Miles)

July 2

1852

Remarks onboard Friday July 2 1852
First part of this day gentle breeze from
N W and cloudy latter part fresh gale from
N by E and sunny saw two shoals of Porpoise
two Barks and two Whalmen one Bark
and one Horn Brig also one Merchant
Schooner by wind the day long off under
John Double reef (Covail & Horn) Dry sail
at sunset (Shore bore N W Dist 25 Miles)
