1852

Remarks onboard Saturday, July 3rd 1852
First part of this day, light breeze from S.W. with heavy rain. Latter part fresh breeze from S.W. and clear. Saw one shoal of Porpoise also two Whalingmen and a Merchant Brig and Bark split the Booms of the ship.

1852

Remarks onboard Sunday, July 4th 1852
First part of this day, fresh breeze from S.W. and pleasant. Latter part of gentle breeze from North and fine.
Lat 38-00 Long 53-05

July 5th

1852

Remarks onboard Monday, July 5th 1852
First part of this day, light air from North and very pleasant. Latter part light air from West. Saw one shoal of Porpoise and one Merchant Brig bound East. Made the Point.

July 6th

1852

Remarks onboard Tuesday, July 6th 1852
First part of this day, light air from S.W. and clear. Latter part fresh breeze from S.W. and cloudy. At noon sailed a shoal of large sperm Whales going to windward quick down and chased all the afternoon, could not get hold.

July 7th

1852

Remarks onboard Wednesday, July 7th 1852
All this day, gentle breeze from S.W. and fair. Saw six Merchantmen bound to the Eastward. Saw one shoal of Porpoise.

Remarks onboard Thursday, July 8th 1852
All this day, gentle breeze from S.W. with light squalls of rain. Saw one Whaling Ship and one shoal of Porpoise also a shoal of Merchantmen.

Remarks onboard Friday, July 9th 1852
All this day, gentle breeze from S.W. and pleasant. Saw one shoal of Blackfish also a Whaling Ship bound to the Eastward and three Merchantmen bound Eastward and one to the Westward.

July 10th

1852

Remarks onboard Saturday, July 10th 1852
First part of this day, gentle breeze from S.W. and pleasant. Latter part gentle breeze from West. Saw one shoal of Porpoise. Saw also a Whaling Bark running Eastward.

July 11th

1852

Remarks onboard Sunday, July 11th 1852
First part of this day, gentle breeze from S.W. with rain. Latter part light air from S.W. and fine. Saw one Merchant Ship.
Lat 38-48 Long 55-05

July 12th

1852

Remarks onboard Monday, July 12th 1852
First part of this day, gentle breeze from S.W. and fine. Latter part gentle breeze from S.E. East. Saw two shoals of Merchantmen.
Lat 39-01 Long 54-44

July 13th

1852

Remarks onboard Tuesday, July 13th 1852
All this day, gentle breeze from North and fine. Saw one Whaling Bark bound East. Saw one shoal of Porpoise. Heard the Whistle Boat and caught a Turtle so ends this day.

July 14th

1852

Remarks onboard Wednesday, July 14th 1852
First part of this day, gentle breeze from S.W. and pleasant. Latter part fresh breeze and squally. Saw one Birdcatcher and a Brig standing to the Westward at Merchantmen.
