First part of this day fresh breeze from North and cloudy latter part gentle breeze saw several shoals of Grampuses and several herons supposed to be Grasspeckles also three Merchant Ships bound Eastward at sunset Clouds low P.C. Dist 25 Miles

Remarks on board Friday Aug 6 1852
First part of this day gentle breeze from N.W. and fine latter part gentle breeze from N.W. saw small shoals of Grampuses and one of Porpoise at sunset Clouds low P.C. Dist 40 Miles

Aug 7

1852

Remarks on board Saturday Aug 7 1852
First part of this day gentle breeze from N.W. and fair latter part fresh breeze from N.W. and cloudy saw small shoals of Grampuses and one of Porpoise at sunset Clouds low P.C. Dist 10 Miles

Aug 8

1852

Remarks on board Sunday Aug 8 1852
First part of this day fresh breeze from N.W. and cloudy latter part gentle breeze from N.W. saw the Brig. Homer Pantaglet 2 Masted sail Chan named with the Iron Chan saw two other Whaling Barks and one large schooner bound Eastward touched at Clouds off the two masts that departed but could not get them and shipped two other Portages men at sunset Clouds low North Dist 4 Miles

Aug 9

1852

Remarks on board Monday Aug 9 1852
First part of this day gentle breeze from E. and cloudy middle calm latter part gentle breeze and fine saw the Brig. Iron by four Merchantmen bound Eastward saw several shoals of Grampuses at sunset Clouds low P.C. Dist 45 Miles

Remarks on board Tuesday Aug 10 1852
First part of this day gentle breeze from N.W. and fine latter part fresh breeze from N.W. saw two shoals of Grampuses and several herons also one ship bound to the Eastward

Remarks on board Wednesday Aug 11 1852
First part of this day fresh breeze from N.W. and fine latter part calm saw two sails bound Eastward saw two shoals of Porpoises saw the top part of a Whack bound the Boat and went to it caught a Barracouta second day

1852

Remarks on board Thursday Aug 12 1852
First part of this day calm latter part gentle breeze from N.W. and fine saw one shoal of Porpoise bound and went to her got two fish
Lat 38=18 Long 94=14

Aug 13

1852

Remarks on board Friday Aug 13 1852
First part of this day gentle breeze from N.W. and fine latter part fresh breeze and cloudy saw one shoal of Grampuses and one shoal of Grampuses saw four sails of Merchantmen bound
Lat 39=25 Long 96=05

Aug 14

1852

Remarks on board Saturday Aug 14 1852
All this day fresh gales from N.W. and cloudy saw three Merchantmen bound Eastward. At ends this day lying to under Clouds inful low sail and storm Squall
Lat 38=40 Long 94=20

Aug 15

1852

Remarks on board Sunday Aug 15 1852
First part of this day fresh breeze from West with heavy rain latter part gentle breeze from N.W. and fine saw four shoals of Porpoises saw six sail of Merchantmen bound Eastward spoke an English Brig bound bound saw a Whaling
