Aug. 16th

1852

Remarks onboard Monday Aug. 16th 1852
First part of this day gentle breeze from North
and fine latter part gentle breeze from East
saw a ship East bound of jib above the Deck
Lat 38-14 Long 35-47

Aug. 17th

1852

Remarks onboard Tuesday Aug. 17th 1852
First part of this day gentle breeze from East
and fine latter part fresh breeze from S.W.
and finally saw one Merchant Bark bound
also another ship saw 4 breeches supposed to be Drunken
saw a dead squid 12 or 15 feet long so ends this day
Lat 38-52 Long 38-25

Aug. 18th

1852

Remarks onboard Wednesday Aug. 18th 1852
First part of this day fresh breeze from S.W.
with heavy rain latter part gentle breeze from North
and fair with a heavy swell saw two breeches supposed
to be Drunken also saw a Whaling ship bound
Lat 39-02 Long 39-29

Aug. 19th

1852

Remarks onboard Thursday Aug. 19th 1852
First part of this day light air from S.W. East
with a heavy swell and fair weather latter part
calm and clear saw one shoal of Porpoises
also one shoal of Grampuses missed the Coward
Lat 38-15 Long 40-50

Aug. 20th

1852

Remarks onboard Friday Aug. 20th 1852
First part of this day calm and clear with a
swell from S.W. latter part gentle breeze from
S.W. and finally saw one shoal of Porpoises
picked up a pillow with the rigging and chain
attached Lat 37-50 Long 39-41

Aug. 21st

1852

Remarks onboard Saturday Aug. 21st 1852
All this day gentle breeze from S.W. West and
fine saw two shoals of Grampuses saw a
Bark bound to the Eastward passed with
the Brig. Fern of Randa 4 Months out when
Lat 36-59 Long 39-02

Aug. 22nd

1852

Remarks onboard Sunday Aug. 22nd 1852
First part of this day gentle breeze from S.W.
and fine latter part calm and clear saw
one shoal of Grampuses saw the Brig. Fern
saw one Merchantman bound to the Eastward
Lat 36-58 Long 36-59

Aug. 23rd

1852

Remarks onboard Monday Aug. 23rd 1852
First part of this day gentle breeze from
S.W. and fine latter part gentle breeze from
S.W. East saw the Brig. Fern and two
Merchantmen bound Eastward saw several
shoals of Porpoises one shoal of Grampuses
and three shoals of Blackfish killed and
brought 5 saved three and set them in
Lat 36-28 Long 37-37

Aug. 24th

1852

Remarks onboard Tuesday Aug. 24th 1852
First part of this day gentle breeze from East
and fine latter part gentle breeze from
E. East and finally saw several breeches
supposed to be Drunken saw the Brig.
Fern also two Merchantmen bound to the East
Lat 36-40 Long 37-07

Aug. 25th

1852

Remarks onboard Wednesday Aug. 25th 1852
All this day gentle breeze from S.W. by East and
cloudy saw a number of shoals of Grampuses and
two shoals of Blackfish spoke an English Brig.
from Singapore bound to the Eastward also saw
three Merchantmen bound to the Eastward
saw a Bark bound to the North West
Lat 36-07 Long 36-47

Aug. 26th

1852

Remarks onboard Thursday Aug. 26th 1852
First part of this day gentle breeze from S.W.
and cloudy latter part calm and clear saw
small shoals of Grampuses one shoal of Porpoises
Lat 35-58 Long 36-51
