Remarks onboard Saturday October 2nd 1852

1852 First part of this day light air from West and
Squally, latter part settled from S.W. and
fine at 8 A.M. saw Medard bearing S.E. by E

Oct 3rd Dist 50 Miles saw one sail caught one Porpoise

1852 Remarks onboard Sunday Oct 3rd 1852

First part of this day light air from S.W. and
and pleasant latter part gentle breeze from S.E. and
and fine saw one Merchantman bound N.W. by W.
Lat. 30-50 Long. 16-50

Oct 4th Remarks onboard Monday Oct 4th 1852

All this day gentle breeze from N.E. and fair
saw two shoals of Grampus and one shoal of
Porpoise saw three sails bound to the N.W. and
at 10 A.M. saw Canoe bearing N.W. by W. Dist 50 Miles

Oct 5th Remarks onboard Tuesday Oct 5th 1852

All this day fresh breeze from N.E. and cloudy
saw two shoals of Porpoise spoke the Brig, bark
of Sandwich 7 Minutes out 90 lbs. spoke also
spoke the Brig. Thomas 3 Minutes out 20 lbs. spoke
at sunset Portentura bore E Dist 8 Miles

Oct 6th Remarks onboard Wednesday Oct 6th 1852

First part of this day fresh breeze from N.E.
and cloudy latter part light breeze from N.E.
and smooth, saw the Brig, Prince Ocean and
a Whaling Bark also a Berm Brig, two Canoes
at sunset Canary bore N.W. Dist 35 Miles

Oct 7th Remarks onboard Thursday Oct 7th 1852

All this day gentle breeze from N.E. and smooth
saw the Brig, Prince also two other sails saw
two Grampus at sunset Portentura bore
E by South Dist 15 Miles so ends this day

Remarks onboard Friday Oct 8th 1852

1852 First and latter part of this day gentle breeze from
N.E. and pleasant middle part calm sun at 11
and Brig, supposed to be a Spanish Merchantman
at sunset Canary bore N.E. Dist 10 Miles

Oct 9th Remarks onboard Saturday Oct 9th 1852

1852 All this day gentle breeze from N.E. and fine
smooth with the Brig. Ocean saw two shoals of
Porpoise one shoal of Grampus saw two Merchantmen
at sunset Canary bore N.W. by W. Dist 30 Miles

Oct 10th Remarks onboard Sunday Oct 10th 1852

1852 First part of this day gentle breeze from N.E. and
and fair latter part gentle breeze from N.E. and
saw a Berm Brig, a bark a Porpoise saw one Grampus
at sunset Portentura bore N.E. Dist 20 Miles

Oct 11th Remarks onboard Monday Oct 11th 1852

1852 All this day gentle breeze from N.E. by North
and pleasant saw one shoal of Porpoise and one
Grampus saw a small Grampus at sunset Canary
bore N.W. Dist 25 Miles so ends this day all well
except the boat in the water think it is a critical
situation on account of eating, want which was spoken

Oct 12th Remarks onboard Tuesday Oct 12th 1852

1852 All this day gentle breeze from N.E. and cloudy
saw two Grampus and two Grampus saw
a Berm Brig, bound N.W. also saw a Whaler a
Boiling at sunset Portentura bore N.E. Dist 15 Miles

Oct 13th Remarks onboard Wednesday Oct 13th 1852

1852 First part of this day fresh breeze from N.E.
and cloudy latter part more moderate and fine
saw one shoal of Porpoise saw at Canoe of
a Whaler spoke the Brig, Prince Boiling four
Whales which they took on Saturday last supposed
to make about 70 lbs so ends this day
at sunset Portentura bore North Dist 10 Miles
