1852

Remarks onboard Thursday Oct 14 1852
All this day, gentle breeze from N.E. by East
saw four shoals of Porpoises. Observed one did not
see him saw the Brig, Phoenix towards this day,
at sunset Pointe-a-Pierre low North Dist 8 Miles

Oct 15

1852

Remarks onboard Friday Oct 15 1852
First part of this day, gentle breeze from S. and
fine latter part, Calm. Saw two shoals of Porpoises,
Capt. Erickson of Brig, Ocean came onboard in
the 120 till at sunset Pointe-a-Pierre low N.W. Dist 8 Miles

Oct 16

1852

Remarks onboard Saturday Oct 16 1852
First part of this day, Calm latter part, gentle
breeze from North and fine saw two shoals of
Porpoises and a humpback saw the Brig Ocean
at sunset Lamerote low N. Dist 15 Miles

Oct 17

1852

Remarks onboard Sunday Oct 17 1852
First part of this day, light air from North and
fair middle part, gale from S.W. and squally,
latter part more moderate, saw the Brig Ocean
at sunset Lamerote low N.W. Dist 19 Miles

Oct 18

1852

Remarks onboard Monday Oct 18 1852
First part of this day, fair breeze from S.W. and
cloudy latter part, fresh gale from S.W. and squally,
with rain saw the Brig Phoenix and Ocean
at sunset Lamerote low North Dist 16 Miles

Oct 19

1852

Remarks onboard Tuesday Oct 19 1852
First part of this day, fresh breeze from S.W.
and squally, latter part, gentle breeze from West and
pleasant saw one Porpoise and one shoal of Porpoises
saw the Brig Ocean and one other sail supported the Phoenix
at sunset Lamerote low N.W. Dist 30 Miles

Oct 20

1852

Remarks onboard Wednesday Oct 20 1852
All this day, gentle breeze from N. and pleasant
saw one shoal of Porpoises and one Sperm whale
the Ocean and Phoenix at half past 4 P.M. raised
a shoal of Sperm whale, killed and took two
supposed to make 25 Wh. Boats. Island bore
N.W. Dist 6 Miles. The barbed boat

Oct 21

1852

Remarks onboard Thursday Oct 21 1852
First part of this day, Calm latter part, light
air from E by S. and clear saw two shoals of
Porpoises. Shot the Brig Ocean out in the two
Whale and started the word at sunset
Pointe-a-Pierre low N.W. Dist 15 Miles. Sperm whale

Oct 22

1852

Remarks onboard Friday Oct 22 1852
All this day, gentle breeze from Calm, saw
Porpoises, Calm and Sperm whale saw the Brig Ocean
went to a large flock of Bay, Wood, caught by
fish to end the day, finished with a well
at sunset Lamerote low N.W. Dist 25 Miles

Oct 23

1852

Remarks onboard Saturday Oct 23 1852
First part of this day, light breeze from Calm
and squally, with Thunder lightning and rain
latter part, gentle breeze from S.W. and cloudy
saw the Ocean also another sail, saw one shoal
of Porpoises. Spent down the Cal. 1.00.00.00
of 15.00.00 of Roddy. This day the Goats breath
he left his Roddy and his Spirit jumped its way
to him that gave it he has been riding since he got the
Paint and he consumed his Roddy to the Ocean
not the Brig Ocean, at sunset Pointe-a-Pierre low N.W. 7 Miles

Oct 24

1852

Remarks onboard Sunday Oct 24 1852
All this day, gentle breeze from N. East and cloudy
saw two shoals of Porpoises saw two Boats. Brig, supposed
to be a Spanish Merchantmen saw the Brig Phoenix Boats
at sunset West end of Pointe-a-Pierre low N. Dist 10 Miles
