 Remarks onboard Saturday Nov 8 1852
 All this day, fresh breeze from S. S. E. and cloudy
 saw the Phoenix again. Whales also several small
 craft half an hour before sunset raised a shoal
 of small sperm Whales toward 15 minutes after
 sunset struck and killed one to send this day
 at sunset total bore S. W. by W. Dist 12 Miles

Row # 1852
 Remarks onboard Sunday Nov 9 1852
 First part of this day, fresh breeze from S. S. E. and
 cloudy, latter part light breeze and clear. Put in the
 Whales and started the whale saw the Phoenix cutting
 and boating saw Spanish Black fish, Whales
 and Killers at sunset total bore S. W. by W. Dist 8 Miles

Row # 1852
 Remarks onboard Monday Nov 10 1852
 All this day, light breeze from Eastward and
 pleasant, saw only shoal of Porpoises. Saw the Big
 Phoenix finished a killing, sent back the boat
 onboard the Phoenix too. Saw a quarter or two
 at sunset total bore S. W. by W. Dist 10 Miles

Row # 1852
 Remarks onboard Tuesday Nov 11 1852
 First part of this day, calm and clear, latter
 part gentle breeze from S. S. E. and very squally
 saw several shoals of Porpoises. Caught one
 20 minutes before sunset saw the Phoenix
 make signal for Whales to end this day
 at sunset Larreroat bore S. E. Dist 5 Miles

Row # 1852
 Remarks onboard Wednesday Nov 12 1852
 First part of this day, fresh breeze from
 S. S. W. and rough latter part, light air from W. by N.
 and fine. Spoke the Ocean with 210 lbs sperm
 spoke the Amela of San Diego 5 months out
 50 lbs sperm saw the Big Phoenix at
 sunset Larreroat bore S. S. E. Dist 5 Miles

 Remarks onboard Thursday Nov 13 1852
 First part of this day, calm latter part gentle
 breeze from West, and fine saw the Vinland
 two humpback three shoals of Porpoises saw
 the Ocean and Amela spoke the Bark
 Ocoba of New Bedford. Christy Master 5
 months out 30 lbs went onboard at sunset
 Larreroat bore South Dist 4 Miles

 Remarks onboard Friday Nov 14 1852
 First part of this day, gentle breeze from West and
 squally with rain latter part gentle breeze from S. W. by W.
 and fine saw the Big, Ocean and Amela
 also two other ships supposed to be Merchants
 at sunset total bore S. W. by W. Dist 12 Miles

 Remarks onboard Saturday Nov 15 1852
 First part of this day, gentle breeze from S. W. by W.
 and fine latter part calm saw the Amela
 also 4 other ships, saw one shoal of Porpoises
 and one of Blackfish toward and struck seven
 and sent 4 and put them in to end this day
 at sunset total bore S. W. by W. Dist 10 Miles

 Remarks onboard Sunday Nov 16 1852
 First part of this day, calm and clear latter part
 gentle breeze from S. W. to S. W. by W. and cloudy
 saw one shoal of Porpoises saw the Phoenix
 Ocean and Amela also four Spanish craft
 at sunset total bore S. W. by W. Dist 10 Miles

Row # 1852
 Remarks onboard Monday Nov 17 1852
 First part of this day, gentle breeze from S. W. by W.
 and fine latter part, fresh breeze from S. W. by W.
 and cloudy, saw the Ocean and the Amela also
 several small craft bound up and down
 the shore. Sailed with the Phoenix took two
 barrels of blubber from her, missed the Blackfish
 when at sunset total bore S. W. by W. Dist 2 Miles
