First part of this day, gentle breeze from N.E. and clear latter part fresh breeze from N.E. and cloudy, saw nothing.

at sunset West Point of Lutterworth Cove S.W. 10

Nov 29

Remarks onboard Monday Nov 29 1852

First part of this day, gentle breeze from N.E. and cloudy, latter part fresh breeze from North and squally, saw two fish, Amela of Sandwich saw two Shoals of Porpoises caught on

at sunset South Point of Lutterworth Cove S.W. 10

Nov 30

Remarks onboard Tuesday Nov 30 1852

All this day, fresh breeze from N.E. and squally, saw Porpoises and caught one. Sailed with the Sch. Amela with 100 lbs. also sailed with the Brig. Ceram with 250 lbs. at sunset West Point of Lutterworth Cove S.W. 10

Dec 1

Remarks onboard Wednesday Dec 1 1852

All this day, fresh breeze from N.E. and squally, saw the Brig. Ceram and Sch. Amela South of Sandwich at sunset the S.W. Point of Lutterworth Cove S.W. 10

Dec 2

Remarks onboard Thursday Dec 2 1852

All this day, fresh breeze from N.E. and cloudy, saw the Brig. Ceram and Sch. Amela at sunset S.W. part of Lutterworth Cove South East Distance 25 Miles

Dec 3

Remarks onboard Friday Dec 3 1852

First part of this day, fresh breeze from N.E. and squally, latter part, gentle breeze from N.E. and fair to good, at 10 miles Canard, and took onboard 15. Mules of Potatoes and Corn at sunset the Town of Palma Cove West Dist 1 Mile

Remarks onboard Saturday Dec 4 1852

First part of this day, gentle breeze from N.E. and fine latter part more moderate and pleasant, commenced Rattling, the Cove and Main Riggings

Dec 5

Remarks onboard Sunday Dec 5 1852

First part of this day, gentle breeze from N.E. and fine latter part clear and pleasant saw a number of Shoals of Porpoises caught one saw four Pinback two Shoals of Sharpfin Blackfish and Cowfish

Dec 6

Remarks onboard Monday Dec 6 1852

First part of this day, gentle breeze from East and clear latter part light air from N.E. by P. have not seen a Cloud for three days saw Porpoises and Cowfish in abundance through two saw rather saw a number of Pinback finches a Rattling, the Cove and Main Riggings and

Dec 7

Remarks onboard Tuesday Dec 7 1852

First part of this day, gentle breeze from N.E. and fine latter part light air from N.E. saw Porpoises Cowfish and Pin

Latt 22-01 Long 18-06

Dec 8

Remarks onboard Wednesday Dec 8 1852

First part of this day, gentle breeze from N.E. and clear latter part fresh breeze from N.E. and cloudy, saw Porpoises Cowfish Pinback and two Shoals of Blackfish and Shoals chased the Pinback more than two hours without water pit and mended it and sent it again to end this day
