Remarks onboard Monday Jan 3 1853
First part of this day, moderate winds from
South to West. Latter part fresh breeze from
S by S and squally with rain and rough at the
tail saw at 4 PM came out of the Gulf Stream
saw two sails round to the East so ends this
Lat 36-32 Long 72-10
