Aug. 18th 1853 Remarks onboard (Thursday) All this day, gentle breeze from W. Saw the Mountain Spring, also the other hills
Lat 31-11 Long 43-18

Aug. 19th 1853 Remarks onboard (Friday) First part of this day, gentle breeze from W. and S.W. latter part gentle breeze from S.W. spoke the Canoe 3 Months out 50 Miles saw the M. Spring
Lat 32-27 Long 43-02

Aug. 20th 1853 Remarks onboard (Saturday) All this day, fresh breeze from East. Saw the Mountain Spring, also the Canoe
Lat 33-02 Long 43-41

Aug. 21th 1853 Remarks onboard (Sunday) All this day, fresh breeze from S.W. and cloudy. Saw the Canoe of Bonaventure
Lat 33-52 Long 43-30

Aug. 22th 1853 Remarks onboard (Monday) All this day, fresh breeze from S.W. and cloudy. Saw the Canoe and two small boats
Lat 34-57 Long 43-07

Aug. 23th 1853 Remarks onboard (Tuesday) All this day, gentle breeze from S.W. saw Blackfish, Grampus, and other small fish of a variety
Lat 35-47 Long 42-57

Aug. 24th 1853 Remarks onboard (Wednesday) All this day, calm. Saw Grampus
Lat 35-11 Long 42-19

Aug. 25th 1853 Remarks onboard (Thursday) First part of this day, calm, latter part light breeze from W. saw Grampus, Blackfish and a large whale. Saw two merchantmen at 12 last. A large whale hauled but could not get hold of him
Lat 35-38 Long 42-59

Aug. 26th 1853 Remarks onboard (Friday) All this day, gentle breeze from W. saw Grampus and two small boats. Supplied the Grampus and saw two Whalmen. Spoke the Canoe of Bonaventure 4 Months out 10 Miles
Lat 36-45 Long 42-17

Aug. 27th 1853 Remarks onboard (Saturday) All this day, moderate breeze from S.W. and saw three shoals of Sperm
Lat 37-10 Long 42-04

Aug. 28th 1853 Remarks onboard (Sunday) All this day, very light air from S.W. spoke the Canoe
Lat 37-06 Long 42-04

Aug. 29th 1853 Remarks onboard (Monday) First part of this day, calm, latter part gentle breeze from S.W. saw Grampus and Blackfish. Saw a ship bound to the East spoke the Canoe of Bonaventure 2 1/2 Months out 15 Miles

Aug. 30th 1853 Remarks onboard (Tuesday) All this day, fresh breeze from S.W. saw the Canoe
Lat 38-14 Long 40-30

Sept. 1st 1853 Remarks onboard (Wednesday) All this day, fresh breeze from S.W. and cloudy. Saw Grampus also a Blackfish
Lat 38-26 Long 37-43

Sept. 2nd 1853 Remarks onboard (Thursday) First part of this day, fresh breeze from S.W. and S.W. latter part light breeze from S.W. and S.W. saw a Merchant Bark and Grampus
Lat 38-41 Long 36-11

Sept. 3rd 1853 Remarks onboard (Friday) All this day, gentle breeze from S.W. to S.E. saw Grampus, Grampus, and Blackfish took one
Lat 38-42 Long 35-38

Sept. 4th 1853 Remarks onboard (Saturday) First part of this day, gentle breeze from S.W. latter part W. saw the Blackfish
Lat 38-06 Long 34-37

Sept. 5th 1853 Remarks onboard (Sunday) First part of this day, gentle breeze from W. and S.W. latter part calm and cloudy
Lat 38-50 Long 33-30

Sept. 6th 1853 Remarks onboard (Monday) First part of this day, calm, latter part fresh breeze from S.W. saw the S.W. also one other ship. Two shoals of Sperm struck one ship did not save him at 4 P.M. saw three herring, S.E. Dist 30 Miles

Sept. 7th 1853 Remarks onboard (Tuesday) All this day, fresh breeze from S.W. and S.W. spoke the Canoe and saw two other Whalmen, Grampus and two Merchantmen and a ship at sunset. S.W. Dist 30 Miles
Lat 39-10 Long 31-00

Sept. 8th 1853 Remarks onboard (Wednesday) First part of this day, fresh breeze from S.W. and S.W. latter part fresh breeze from S.W. saw four Whalmen, Bark and ship
Lat 39-10 Long 30-00

Sept. 9th 1853 Remarks onboard (Thursday) First part of this day, fresh breeze from S.W. latter part moderate breeze from S.W. saw one Whalman, Bark, two Merchantmen, saw one shoal of Sperm and fish
Lat 39-10 Long 29-00

Sept. 10th 1853 Remarks onboard (Friday) First part of this day, gentle breeze from S.W. latter part from S.W. saw two sail of Merchantmen bound to the East and so ending at sunset. Canoe bore S.W. Dist 30 Miles
