 Remarks onboard Monday May 1st 1854
 All this day gentle breeze from South and fair
 saw several whales also a steam ship down the
 Lat 30-49 Long 77-04
 May 2nd 1854
 Remarks onboard Tuesday May 2nd 1854
 First part of this day light air from S.E. latter
 part calm saw a large ship bound for the
 Lat 30-16 Long 77-47
 May 3rd 1854
 Remarks onboard Wednesday May 3rd 1854
 First part of this day calm latter part gentle
 breeze from S.W. saw two steamships and a sail
 Lat 29-55 Long 78-04
 May 4th 1854
 Remarks onboard Thursday May 4th 1854
 First part of this day gentle breeze from S.W.
 latter part calm towards the coast and took a pull
 Lat 28-24 Long 78-14
 May 5th 1854
 Remarks onboard Friday May 5th 1854
 First part of this day calm latter part light
 air from S.W. saw one ship of "Bampholch"
 Lat 29-55 Long 78-55

 Remarks onboard Saturday May 6th 1854
 All this day light air from S.W. and S.W. by W.
 spoke the bark "Barley" 187 tons and killed
 one at 2 P.M. a school of sperm whales
 lowered and hauled one supposed to make 50 barrels
 Lat 30-28 Long 78-34
 May 7th 1854
 Remarks onboard Sunday May 7th 1854
 First part of this day wind all around the compass
 and S.W. by W. Thunder beginning rain in the
 part fresh breeze from S.W. and southerly and started the
 motor Lat 30-20 Long 78-00
 May 8th 1854
 Remarks onboard Monday May 8th 1854
 All this day fresh breeze from East saw one sail
 so ends this day a boisterous
 Lat 30-55 Long 77-05
 May 9th 1854
 Remarks onboard Tuesday May 9th 1854
 All this day gentle breeze from S.E. and fair
 saw none so ends this day boisterous
 Lat 30-45 Long 77-55
 May 10th 1854
 Remarks onboard Wednesday May 10th 1854
 All this day gentle breeze from S.E. and fair
 saw several whales killed at boiling and
 stored down 37 bl of blubber & 18 bl of head
 Lat 30-20 Long 77-17
 May 11th 1854
 Remarks onboard Thursday May 11th 1854
 All this day gentle breeze from S.E. and fair
 saw the bark "Barley" 187 tons but took nothing
 Lat 30-40 Long 78-42
 May 12th 1854
 Remarks onboard Friday May 12th 1854
 All this day gentle breeze from S.E. and
 fair saw the bark "Barley" so ends this day
 Lat 30-40 Long 78-54
 May 13th 1854
 Remarks onboard Saturday May 13th 1854
 All this day fresh breeze from East and fair
 saw one sail so ends this day all well
 Lat 29-50 Long 78-49
