 more "Whales" hoisted at 2 P.M. and "Horn"
 with the "Spartan" "Bark" did not get hold
 took up the "Bark" at 4 P.M. at 5 P.M. raised
 more "Whales" it being so near night did not
 lower

 All this day, light air from S.E. saw the "Spartan" also
 at 27
 77-00
 5 sail of Merchantmen at 2 P.M. sailed a "Horn"
 "Whale" hoisted took one "Spartan" to make 30. All
