First part of this day gentle breeze from South
later part breezy and we the schooner passed
saw the M^o Colonel and three Merchantsmen

June 14

1854

Remarks onboard Wednesday June 14 1854
First part of this day breezy with squalls
lightning and rain later part gentle breeze
from S.W. and fine saw several wharves
supposed to be Grampian saw one M^o ship supposed
to be the M^o Colonel saw two Merchantsmen

June 15

1854

Remarks onboard Thursday June 15 1854
First part of this day gentle breeze from N.W.
later part breeze saw Grampian once beyond
the M^o Colonel saw two Merchantsmen

June 16

1854

Remarks onboard Friday June 16 1854
First part of this day calm latter part light
air from E. saw the ship supposed to be Merchantsmen
saw the M^o Colonel so ended this day

June 17

1854

Remarks onboard Saturday June 17 1854
All this day gentle breeze from E. saw
the M^o Colonel in chase of Whaler
at 2 P.M. raised the Whaler toward the boat
and crashed in company with the M^o Colonel
they being so wide that we could not get hold

June 18

1854

Remarks onboard Sunday June 18 1854
In this day with breeze from E. and steady
saw the M^o Colonel so ended this day

June 19

1854

Remarks onboard Monday June 19 1854
All this day gentle breeze from E. and fine
saw the M^o Colonel so ended this day
all well

1854

Remarks onboard Tuesday June 20 1854
All this day gentle breeze from S.E. and fine
saw the M^o Colonel at 1 P.M. raised two from
Whaler toward ship killed both took them
along side supposed to make 100 lbs. so ended this day
Lat 29-00 Long 78-25

June 21

1854

Remarks onboard Wednesday June 21 1854
All this day light air from S.E. and fine
saw Blackbird and Grampian cut in both
Whaler and started the work so ended this day
Lat 29-12 Long 77-58

June 22

1854

Remarks onboard Thursday June 22 1854
All this day gentle breeze from South and fine
with the appearance of a synall in two this day
Lat 29-17 Long 77-44

June 23

1854

Remarks onboard Friday June 23 1854
First part of this day fine in a wind South
later part squally saw three Merchantsmen
saw the M^o Colonel so ended this day
Lat 29-40 Long 77-15

June 24

1854

Remarks onboard Saturday June 24 1854
All this day gentle breeze from S.W. and
fine finished boiling saw two Merchantsmen
Lat 29-00 Long 77-57

June 25

1854

Remarks onboard Sunday June 25 1854
All this day gentle breeze from S.W. and fine
saw the M^o Colonel so ended this day
Lat 29-53 Long 77-50

June 26

1854

Remarks onboard Monday June 26 1854
First part of this day light air from S.W.
saw the M^o Colonel so ended this day
Lat 29-43 Long 77-47

June 27

1854

Remarks onboard Tuesday June 27 1854
First part of this day calm later part light
air from S.W. so ended this day all well
Lat 29-25 Long 77-40
